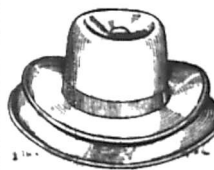

We have purposely ENCOURAGING refrained hitherto SETTLEMENT. from expressing any opinion on the controversy regarding the suitability or otherwise of Kenya as a future home for retiring officials of the Indian Services, either as farmers or as landlords in the various towns and their suburbs as we opined there would have been more correspondence on the subject that that received from Mr. Cook, of Kyamba, and the Secretary of the Land Settlement Advisory Board. We are even now by no means desirous of taking sides, even though our opinions may be very decided, but there are aspects of the case, for and against, that might well be set forth for the guidance of those who might have in contemplation settlement in the Colony. That the limit of hard times is almost over; that the tide is turning and that there is every indication of a long-delayed forward move we are ready to admit, but it is idle to deny that Kenya at present is not an absolutely ideal place for the man of small means, though he may decide that relatively it is the best. Such an one, if he starts to farm, may be called on to invest practically his all in the purchase of land and the primary needs of the farm,

even, ploughs and so on, and then to wait for—a quiet Major Grogan—the "sun-burn period," the advent of which may be long delayed by circumstances uncontrollable or unforeseen. With no desire to disparage the land we live in, but, on the contrary, to do all in our power to assist its future settlement, we incline to the belief that it is not in the best interests of outsiders whom we may invite to settle, among us to point primarily to vague aspects of a spot and to suggest these as open to the many, rather than to the very few who may be in possession of faster, more capital than is the lot of the average man, and who may secure and in a district where sport is abundant, rather than any, attention to some-thing of any kind, we would tell us now-comes this residence in Kenya for those seeking their living out of the soil, implies and necessitates work, hard work, and, for some time to come, nothing but work. We cannot see why so honest a statement should deter any man who genuinely means to use his best efforts to make his future operations a success, from selecting the Colony to start in. There are many farmers among us to-day, the vast majority who venture to secure, who are content to forego sport and the pleasures of social life on many farms, and to devote their energies to the duties they have taken on themselves and, from those, few, if any, complaints are heard of the lonely life they live or the hard and uninteresting work they are compelled to do. This, then, is the class of men we would like to see invited to Kenya; he would battle

CATTLE DISEASES

Below is the Veterinary Report for the month of June, 1922.—

Rinderpest.

An outbreak was reported from the Lumumba District. The quarantine has been revoked in the Kericho area. A previous outbreak is still in quarantine in the Eldoret district.

Pleuro-Pneumonia.

In the Eldoret district two farms remain in quarantine and one quarantine has been revoked. In the Lumumba district one quarantine has been revoked.

Foot and Mouth Disease.

The fresh outbreak reported from Nakuru district. A previous outbreak remains in quarantine in the Rumuruti District. The quarantine has been revoked for a previous outbreak in the Nakuru district.

Horse Sickness.

Ten outbreaks have been reported from the Nakuru district causing a mortality of twenty-four animals. In the Nakuru district thirty-eight cases were reported with a very high mortality. Cases were also reported from the Lumumba (5), Rumuruti (2) and Nyeri (1) districts.

East Coast Fever.

Fresh outbreaks have been reported in the districts of Nakuru (3), Eldoret (5), Mombasa (3), Lumumba (2), and Nyeri (1).

Contagious Abortion.

One outbreak from Nakuru.

Eptizootic Lymphangitis.

Nakuru five cases reported, two of which have been destroyed. From the Lumumba district two cases destroyed.

Ulcerative Lymphangitis.

Nakuru five cases reported, four destroyed. Eldoret nine cases reported and four destroyed. Two cases reported from Lumumba.

Anthrax.

One fresh outbreak in Nakuru district causing three deaths. In the Nakuru district four fresh outbreaks causing one death in each outbreak.

Trypanosomiasis.

Nakuru district five fresh outbreaks. Seven previous outbreaks remain in quarantine. Three quarantines revoked. In the Rumuruti District one fresh outbreak.

Blackquarter.

In the Nakuru district one outbreak causing eight deaths.

Burula Fever.

One outbreak in the Nakuru district causing fourteen deaths.

White Scour.

One outbreak in the Nakuru and Rumuruti Districts.

Sheep Pox.

Eldoret one outbreak with a mortality of eight animals. One outbreak in the Nyeri District.

Sheep Scap.

Two fresh outbreaks in the Rumuruti District in a flock of Grade Merino Sheep.

Protoplasmic.

Two outbreaks have been reported from the Nakuru and Nakuru Districts. One outbreak in the Eldoret District.

Three Days Sickness.

Nakuru district one outbreak causing two deaths.

Kihayu Fowl Disease.

Nairobi district one outbreak.

Belton is more than one "frog" or button used to keep the right breast well over on the left, but that one performs all that is needed of it. Length is a matter for the individual to judge, and personally I like mine the ankle length, especially amongst those who like to use the dressing-gown as a rest robe.

Of course, if you only want a dressing-jacket, the pattern could be cut off at the hips. If you do not care to undertake the stencilling choose a bold simple design and work it in wools or artificial silk. I can't say that I care for some of the beaded models, they look out of place on a dress of any sort. Without the collar an edging of satin-stuff could be added, especially if you have chosen pink satin for the garment.
