Paris, August 2. The text of M. Ballou's reply to Germany shows that France requires an assurance that £2,000,000 will be paid by August 31. Coercive measures are threatened in the absence of an assurance by August 5 and the Note adds that the very complete plan for such measures has been decided on, but will not be disclosed at present.

Berlin, August 1.

The British acknowledgment of Germany's request for the reduction of private debts, payments is much milder than the French note, and states that Great Britain will discuss the question with her Allies as soon as possible with a view to delivering a joint reply.

Meanwhile Germany is replying to the French Note pointing the impossibility of continuing monthly payments of 20,000,000 gold marks on this account simultaneously with the operation of reparations.

The note protests against French threats and says Germany makes every effort to fulfil her obligations, but this presupposes the restoration of her economic health which can only be effected through the speedy settlement of all her debts.

ITALIAN CRISIS

GENERAL STRIKE AND A NEW CABINET.

ROME, August 1.

A general strike throughout Italy has been ordered by the Fascist Labour League as a protest against the proposed inclusion of Fascist and the Right in the Cabinet. The Government have taken every care to cope with the strike, which it is thought will be a success.

HONOURS SCANDAL

COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY APPOINTED.

LONDON, August 2.

In the House of Commons Mr. Lloyd George announced the composition of the Commission to inquire into the conferment of honours as follows: Lord Dundas, (chairman) Lord Dunsany, Mr. Arthur Henderson, M.P., the Hon. Evelyn Cecil, Sir Samuel Hoare and Sir George Murray. The Earl of Derbyshire had been invited but had not yet replied.

EXIT BOTTOMLEY

EXPLAINS FROM THE HOUSE OF COMMONS.

LONDON, August 1.

The House of Commons has an air of gravity on the occasion of Mr. Bottomley's resignation. The Prime Minister stated the terms of reference would not involve retrospective enquiry.

INDIA

PRIME MINISTER AND BRITAIN'S SACRED DUTY.

THE CIVIL SERVICE.

(THROUGH MEXICO'S AGENT.)

In the House of Commons in the course of a debate on the article of British Civil Servants in India in regard to the effect of the constitutional reforms on their position, Mr. Lloyd George said despite the drawbacks there had been a very satisfactory measure of success in the great experiment of self-government in India but the real test would be whether the Moderates or the British Conservatives were reduced to the next election.

If the latter came in this would constitute a serious situation of which Great Britain would have to take account.

He emphatically declared Britain would never relinquish her responsibilities in India and would take whatever steps were necessary to discharge or enforce them, because the withdrawal of the strong hand of Great Britain from India would result in anarchy.

The British Civil Service must remain in India and the Government would see that they had full play.

The British Empire must at all costs be maintained and the Government would see that they had full play.

RAILWAY COMBINE

MANY GREAT LINES IN NEW COMPANY.

LONDON, August 2.

A big step in railway re-organization is announced in the form of the amalgamation of the Great Central, Great Eastern, Great Northern, Great North of Scotland and North British lines and 23 small companies with a total capital of £348,000,000.

THE AIR FORCE

GOVERNMENT AGREES TO LARGE INCREASE.

LONDON, August 2.

It is reported that the proposed Defence Air Force will consist of 20 squadrons with a full quota of machines making 400 to 500 machines.

NO PROTECTION OF FAR EAST STATIONS.

LONDON, August 2.

In the House of Commons, Viscount Curzon (C. S. Battersby) asked whether there were any British despatch stations, or naval establishments abroad other than at Malta.

THE WORLD'S SEPMEN

PARIS CONFERENCE AND NEW DEMANDS.

PARIS, August 2.

The International Seamen's Conference has decided to issue a manifesto demanding a 45-hour week and a 10-day minimum wage. The conference is expected to be held in London in the near future.

GREEKS AND TURKS

ALLIED REFUSAL TO BREAK NEUTRALITY.

BORDER CROSSED.

(THROUGH MEXICO'S AGENT.)

Constantinople, August 1. The Foreign Minister has presented a Note to the Allied High Commissioners expressing the hope that all steps will be taken to prevent the violation of the neutrality of Constantinople in view of the movement of the Greeks. He estimates that 30,000 Greek troops are in Thrace.

The Minister of the Interior announced that he has received formal assurances from the Allied authorities regarding the neutrality of the occupied territories.

Albino, August 1. The British, French and Italian representatives have insisted the Foreign Minister M. Ballou's answer to the Greek Note, regarding the Greek request for free passage of Greeks to Constantinople and have been ordered to oppose any Greek advance.

A British communiqué states that Greek concentration of troops in Eastern Thrace continues and military and naval preparations for hostilities are being made to violate the neutral zone are going on.

Greek cavalry crossed the frontier at Kerkirli this morning. Turkish police fired and the Greeks withdrew leaving three killed and one wounded. Greek patrols occupied a farm at Sarilim on the line of demarcation and a French officer has demanded an explanation.



A HEAVY LOSS.

One of the most daring and successful burglaries in the history of Nairobi was perpetrated on Saturday afternoon last at the residence of Messrs. R. O. Hamilton Ltd., the well-known agents, of Hastings Street.

The misdoers, who apparently were well acquainted with the position of the safe, approached by means of a ladder erected in front of the gate of the premises from the railway line between Hastings Street and Government Road. At the end of the safe was from the back door and window of Messrs. Hamilton's store.

The window was heavily barred and the door double-locked, but this did not deter the burglars from their purpose. By means of a long ladder and another plan of effort, they succeeded in passing through the wall alongside of the window.

They must have put in a considerable amount of work on the wall, which is about 18 inches thick, and they made a hole in the masonry large enough for a grown man to crawl through, and gained entry into the premises.

The burglars do not appear to be content with the goods, and once inside they made a very careful selection of the stuff which was to be taken away. All goods being packed in boxes and sent to the station in a motor van. They closed the door of all the safes and also took off with a large amount of other articles. The value of the goods missing is estimated at about £200.

The firm, which does a large business in safes, is at present busy at work in an attempt to determine the department owing to now having stopped.

The work does not appear to have been carried out by the ordinary nature thief, but by a trained gang of persons who know their way about. The police have the honor in hand and are in possession of a number of very useful fingerprints which, it is hoped, will lead to the identification of the perpetrators of the crime.

It seems, however, to be somewhat of a mystery as to why the affair was discovered by the police as the burglar did not bother to open the safe-door when he passed it to see if all was well, or, at least, having seen what was going on, was put off by the very burglar nature of the affair and thought it was a building which was being done up, and did not think of reporting it.

NATIVE LOAFERS.

Nairobi has for some considerable time suffered from periodical epidemics of burglaries and other crimes, perpetrated chiefly by natives.

The police, although handicapped in many ways, have long been doing their utmost to cope with this menace, but appear to have been unable effectively to put a stop to these series of crimes.

Their chief handicap in dealing with this question is the very slight control they have of the unemployed natives in the town, who, it is to be supposed, are chiefly responsible for what goes on.

A conversation with a senior police official recently revealed the fact that the police are extremely anxious to obtain control over all the natives of the town, and to confine and detain responsibility for them.

Only in this way can the dangerous unemployed element be effectively supervised.

The only law in existence under which the police can effect any sort of control is the Vagrancy Ordinance, and this measure, it would appear, gives little opportunity for dealing with the unemployed and unemployed criminal class since it deals in general terms such as "without visible means of subsistence," and while a native has even a minute sum in his possession and can say that he is living in one of the villages with a brother, sister, cousin or aunt, and although he may have done no work for years, he cannot be termed a vagrant and the police are powerless.
