In the House of Commons, Capt. J. Wedgwood (Labour) moved the suspension of the Reparations Committee Act of 1923 on the ground that some of the financial terms were still uncertain, and on account of the situation in the Ruhr.

Mr. Stanley Baldwin (Conservative) said that the German Government had been asked to make a loan, which would shortly be decided.

The German Government credits the French with having reported to the League of Nations that Germany had been responsible for the working of the Ruhr.

The German Government has given a loan of £7,000,000 since April, and also a sum of £1,000,000.

There was no sign hitherto, however, of any final loan being made, and it was decided at a while with Germany.

The loan was rejected by 120 votes to 71.

More Royalists Arrested.

Stirling, March 26.—The police have arrested two ex-officers and Herr Rosenthal's representative of complicity in the alleged plot recently discovered by the police.

Herr Rosenthal, who is the head of the movement, was arrested five days ago.




