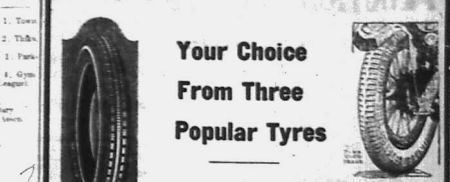

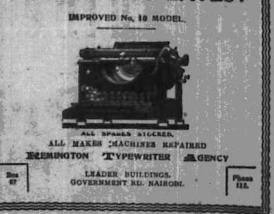

The Acting Colonial Secretary, without yesterday's date says—

"I have the honor to inform you that the Secretary of State has instructed that His Excellency the Governor has been instructed to take immediate steps on his return to implement the decision with regard to immigration on restricted to the cable published in the Special Gazette of July 26th."

"Further, some arrangement must be devised for carrying the strictly imperial examination of applications for entry into Kenya, possibly by a board on which the various communities including the natives would be represented. It will therefore be an instruction to the Governor of Kenya to explore the matter further on his return to the Colony and to concert with an instruction to Uganda to obtain proposals to the Secretary of State for the Colonial Dept giving effect to that amount of control of immigration which the economic interests of the natives of both Dependencies require."

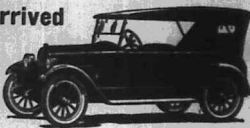

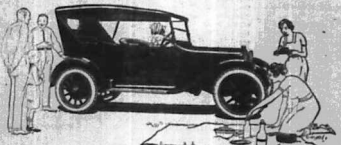
