

OUTBREAKS OF VARIOUS DISEASES

Over Thirty Two Thousand Head of Cattle Inoculated in a Year.

The report of the Chief Veterinary Officer of the year ended December 31, 1922 on Rinderpest and the Department—fully detailed in numbers—to go with outbreaks in widely separated parts of considerable interest to all stockmen. The first portion of the report is as follows:

Provision must be given to the operations which have been undertaken in the Native Reserves. In most of the Native Reserves Rinderpest and Pleuro-pneumonia, the two most serious diseases which at present menace the Lambeas and Nandi Reserves and all outbreaks of these diseases in the European areas are traceable either directly or indirectly, to extension of infection from these areas. If, therefore, Veterinary operations are carried out in a successful manner, the spread in the native stock-owners would therein benefit, but the European owners would be more economically and effectively safeguarded than they can be by any other means.

The operations in the Nandi and Lambeas Reserves, where they have gone, have been markedly successful and reflect credit on the Veterinary staff of the Department. The efforts of this staff have not been only supported by the Veterinary Officers concerned and the staff of the Department, but also by those Officers who have expressed their willingness to have their cattle treated with respect and Pleuro-pneumonia by the Veterinary staff.

The number of cattle vaccinated in the year ended December 31, 1922, was 32,700 head of cattle. The vaccination against Pleuro-pneumonia being carried out free of charge.

When a considerable number of cattle had been dealt with in this manner, the Veterinary staff were enabled to have more time to devote to the investigation of cases of Rinderpest and Pleuro-pneumonia which were reported to them.

In the Nakuus district the deaths resulted from all causes. The majority of these deaths occurred in four herds; in one of these the principal cause of death was septicaemia, which was traced to the introduction of the disease from the other herds.
