The Town of Haibori is the Capital of Kenya Colony and has a population of 40,000, which is an additional population in the area of supply (European, Asiatic, and African) of approximately 100,000.

The supply of electricity at Nairobi was commenced in the year 1916, power being generated at Haibori Works connected with the town by overhead line. In 1918 it became necessary to augment the supply by an auxiliary steam station in the town and this has been further increased from time to time. The total capacity of the undertaking is now 1200 horse-power.

There is an increasing demand for supply in the Company's area far in excess of the present plant, and in order to meet this growing demand it was decided in the year 1919 to build a new plant on the Tuka River, which is about 33 miles distant from Nairobi. MOBASA UNDER TAKING.
The Island of Mombasa is a population of approximately 80,000 European, Asiatic, and African.

Kilindini and Mombasa are the only ports of Kenya Colony, Uganda and the Eastern Congo, the latter being the sea terminals of the railway leading to the interior.

The existing plant at Mombasa includes the following: The Directors have entered into a contract with the Foundation Company, Limited, of Windsor House, Kingsway, W.C. 2 for the construction of a new generating station and the necessary plant and equipment to meet the present and increasing demands for light and power. The value of a new site has been acquired, a portion of the construction work is already well in hand, and one generating set has been dispatched.

LIENCES.
The Company has been granted licences by the Governor in Council of the Kenya Colony and Protectorate under the provisions of the Electric Power Ordinance, 1919, authorizing previous concessions granted to the old companies. The generating and distributing licences for Nairobi are for a period of 25 years and authorizes the Company to distribute and supply electrical energy in and around Nairobi for approximately 700 square miles. The generating licence authorizes the Company to generate electrical energy for the purpose of the distributing licence and to transmit and maintain power stations in the Haibori Works. The generating and distributing licences for the Town of Mombasa (including the Island) are for a period of 42 years.

The distributing licences are very comprehensive and cover demands for lighting and power for all purposes. The maximum prices fixed by the Governor for a period of five years from the grant thereof are 30 cents per kilowatt (the Board of Trade unit) for all classes of power and 100 cents per kilowatt for lighting. The rate is one-hundredth part of a condition approved by the Governor in Council depending upon the nature, use and other circumstances of the demand and the expiration of five years, and any method of charge so approved is open to further revision by the Governor in Council at the expiration of any further five years.

POWERS UNDER ORDINANCE.
Section 4 of the Electric Power Ordinance, 1919, expressly prohibits any public or local authority, company, or person, other than licensee under such Ordinance, from erecting, maintaining, or supplying a district from supplying, laying, constructing or maintaining any electric supply line for supply of electrical energy beyond the premises in which

the electrical energy is generated. It also provides that no public or local authority may use any form of energy for power or lighting purposes (except portable lighting purposes) other than electrical energy without the authority of the Governor in Council. This provision is made in order to secure to the licensee the sole right to generate and supply electrical energy in the Colony.

The Ordinance further provides that no public body or local authority, not being a licensee under the Ordinance, may generate electrical energy for any purpose other than for its own use, and that no authority not being a licensee shall use any form of energy for power or lighting purposes other than electrical energy without the authority of the Governor in Council. This provision is made in order to secure to the licensee the sole right to generate and supply electrical energy in the Colony.

Section 7 of the Ordinance provides that no licensee shall be granted for any area within the limit of economic licensee purposes, or the generation of electrical energy on such areas within the limit of economic licensee purposes, unless the licensee first offers for the construction of supply lines and other works necessary for the purposes of the Company, including power to break up streets, subject to the consent of the local authority. The profits on the same basis for the first year of the present Company were certified by Messrs. Gill & Johnson as follows: 1922 Shillings 414,700 £23,175. TANGANYIKA CROPS. PLAGUE AT MOMBASA.

Good Rains Improve Cotton Prospects. Further Cases Might be Expected.

RICE CROP FAILS.

The Tanganyika Inspector of Agriculture reports that good rains have fallen everywhere in August in the rice-growing districts, and the crops are said to be very excellent. The food position will improve through the good rice harvest which is expected to be well.

FLAX MARKET REPORT.

Mr. A. H. Todd, representing Wm. F. Moleben and Co., of London forwards the following report dated London, September 2.

There is still no improvement to report in the Flax market, and the position if anything continues to be unchanged.

Since the beginning of August over 3000 tons of various Scotch Flax have been sent into the Country on assignment and warehouse, and in the first 4000 tons which were unloaded at the end of July, does not improve the position for sellers. At the moment we reckon that there are over 2000 tons of un-sold British Flax lying at Peterhead, the various Baltic Ports and the warehouses in this Country and on the Continent.

An estimate of the new crop Flax begins to come into the inferior markets after the middle of October, the position of holders of stock is not a very happy one.

Today's prices are purely nominal, but are for a neighbourhood of 400 for Medium Baltic Flax, top mark, and 250 for the bottom mark. Favorable crop reports continue to come in from all the Flax-growing Countries.
