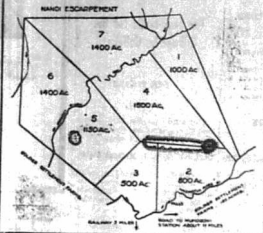

INSULIN TREATMENT.

Diabetes Cure at London Hospital.

BOY'S LIFE SAVED.

Jack Kingley, a five-year-old boy, whose parents had been from South Africa dying from diabetes last year, was cured at the London Hospital. As a consequence involving all diabetes last year, Kingley, the chairman, informed the committee that the boy had been brought to the hospital as a desperate case to cure. His life there was almost five years in the hospital receiving insulin treatment. At the time, it had been decided, could be admitted, but there could be no question in this case.

The patient was in a state of diabetic coma, but responded at once to the insulin treatment. He was practically a skeleton, and at the point of death, when he left the hospital, but his whole system reacted so quickly to the treatment that he got quite fat and well, and was extremely lively and cheerful.

This case is regarded as a wonderful example of the effectiveness of the new treatment, the great drawback to which, since from the onset, which amounts to 2 1/2 weeks, is that it must be continued after the patient leaves hospital. On this ground, some cases have already been severely restricted, and the London Hospital has used £1,000 to the supply of insulin to patients who had left the hospital, but the fact is that the hospital, it was stated, are now employing the treatment.

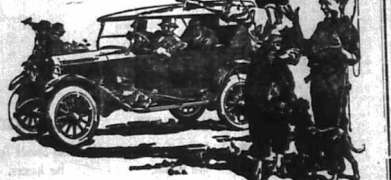

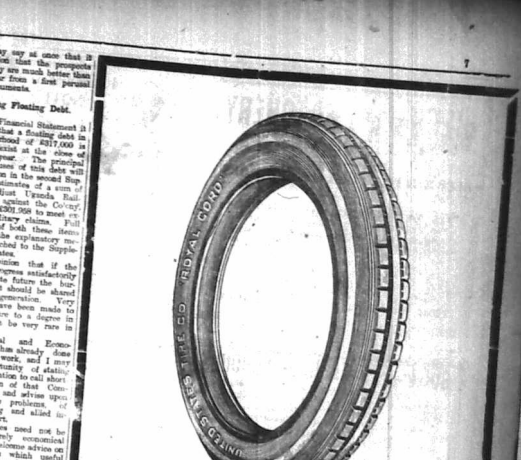
