India in the Empire was fully debated by
 the Imperial Conference on the 2nd and 3rd
 instants. Sir T. Bagehot will preside at the

 paid a tribute to the government
 of New Zealand for treating Indians

 Indians could live there as
 citizens in honor. The franchise
 in Australia was compared
 unfavorably with that of New
 Zealand. He hoped Mr. Duggan
 would be able to secure the
 franchise and remove the dis-
 qualifications in regard to land
 not only in Queensland, but
 also in New South Wales and
 Western Australia. He
 hoped Mr. Duggan would extend
 the franchise to the whole of
 the Dominion within the next
 few months. He was willing to
 concede with Mr. Brown to the
 fact that the franchise was
 not the solution of the
 difficulties.

South Africa and Tanganyika.

Sir T. Bagehot said the most
 important part of the Indian
 problem was the one in South
 Africa where the problem was
 acute. There were 250,000
 Indians in South Africa of whom
 150,000 were politically disenfranchised while the
 remainder were under various
 disabilities and the Union Govern-
 ment was now contemplating
 legislation providing for the com-
 pulsory segregation of Indians in
 urban areas or restrictions in the
 ownership and occupation of land.
 He said that he had spoken to
 Indians in the Colonies. Sir T.

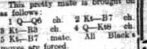

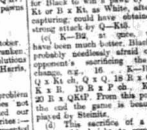

GOLD STORAGE.

Cattle breeders would read with some disquiet the statement made by His Excellency the Governor few days ago in the Legislative Council that, in his view, practically the only hope for the cattle industry in this country lay in the establishment of a most extensive syndicate. We are of course glad when his Excellency has so far as to say to the Argentine the Chief Veterinary Officer of the three territories and the Hon. Mr. Robert Coryndon. We hope that something will be done which will be of benefit to the country. But we disagree entirely with his pessimism in regard to the cattle industry as a whole and we are disappointed that the faith he once laid in regard to the value of stock in the Colony of Kenya and its neighbours has now, by his own confession, departed from him. If he wishes the same common sense and energy to assist the cattle industry we had done in other directions, we do not doubt that the result will give himself and the country cause for satisfaction. There have been various features of recent events which are most likely to result to the mind of His Excellency. He has himself announced his intention to ask the Downing Committee to investigate the position and possibilities of the dairy industry and allied practices of stockbreeding; and the functions of the newly constituted Shipping Commission, which includes the stability of coffee and steel are the mainstays of commerce, the stability of the market, searching with heavy hands for outside for export surpluses. BILLS IN COUNCIL

New Legislation Passes Second Reading.

TRESPASS DIFFICULTIES

In the Legislative Council on Friday afternoon, further progress was made with the Bill which had been introduced earlier in the week.

The Agricultural Pardon, Etc. Bill Amendment Ordinance passed through its committee stage and was reported in Council.

The following Bills were also put through their committee stage on Friday afternoon:—
Roads Duty Amendment Ordinance, Maintenance Orders Enforcement Amendment Ordinance, Laidly's Courts Amendment Ordinance.

Native Taxation

When the Council assembled on Friday, the Chief Native Commissioner introduced a new Bill to amend the Native Hut and Poll Tax (Amendment) Bill. The purpose of the Bill was to impose certain difficulties in respect of tax collection. It also altered the period covered by the tax which was hitherto April 1 to March 31 in a period extending from January 1 to December 31 and was to be paid before November 1.

The first reading was passed. The Chief Native Commissioner moved on Friday afternoon the second reading of a Bill to amend and amend the law as relating to trespas.

In moving to the motion, Mr. Maxwell said the principle of the law, set out by the Bill, provided for the prohibition of some which were being applied to both the present. Complaints had been made that certain trespas, had taken place, chiefly by natives, on forest land, and undisturbed forest land.

Under this Ordinance, the Governor could prohibit any area to be protected, and thereby would keep the land without authority. Any building erected could be removed and stock confiscated. In order that the Ordinance should fall to handle, such prohibited land should be dealt with by a Magistrate or by the District Commissioner (Mr. Truitt) should.

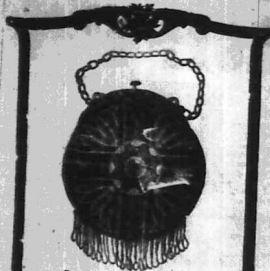

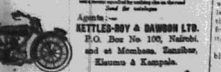
