Serious Problem in Rift
District.

HEAVY CROPS IN PROGRESS.

A state of affairs exists in the
districts of which there are no
possible instruments in giving an
adequate relief for a large body of
Cotton Planters.

The situation is generally
one of acute distress, as the
crops are incompletely sown and
will be ready for harvest within
the next two weeks, in fact so many
as possible is ready now.

Opposite Labour.

It is known on good authority
that the labour supply—except
for those men or women and their
wives who are members of present
communities—is practically
non-existent. The local labour
is hopelessly independent
and will not be induced to work
unless he is paid more than he
can earn.

Planters, it is stated, are at
present in a position where they
are unable to find sufficient
labour and are, in some cases,

paying extra prices for picking.

continues, the Government
should issue a decree that
no more labourers than would
be necessary for the normal
operation of a cotton farm should
be employed. This would
enable the planter to pay less
and still have his cotton
picked.
