DEVELOPMENT OF THE COAST

Divided Options on Roads

COAST POLICY NEEDED.

Further extracts from the valuable report on Coast roads and development are given below:

The Coast roads in all grades will in all probability be covered in the foreign trade areas suitable markets for native production will strengthen as native production increases.

The Coast road which starts from Nairobi will have the character of a main steamer road. It may be thought that the development of coast roads could be left to the port authority. The writer wishes to emphasise that the coast roads and the roads inland also need improvement.

The improvement of roads has been suggested by many. The writer suggests that for this reason every effort should be directed to the improvement of roads, not of railways, applying this to those roads which serve the vessels to carry for food.

The improvement of roads, however, should not be the sole consideration. There must also be provision for power ports and to expand energy on rail and road lines to reduce potential production.

Mr. Berthold Oppenheim. —

I cannot agree that this writing should be left to the port authority. In my opinion the improvement of roads should be left to the port authority before the Coast roads because making of a trunk road north of Mombasa would be a very great diversion and if this road were made there would be no room for a motor traffic leading in produce from the country areas.

The same applies to the south. If there were a trunk road to Nairobi there would be a great deal more native traffic on that road.

I agree that the present native roads are unable to withstand the present needs. They could, however, be brought up to standard. From Nairobi to Mombasa there would be a trunk road and good tracks leading from Nairobi to the coast.

It is obvious that an attempt to stimulate greater interest in the road network, particularly the road network, existing Mombasa mediation should be made.

We are impressed by the unscientific appeal from Mr. Dated. We hope that the Government after careful consideration will recognise the value of this proposal and encourage it. A medical campaign should be instituted forthwith to





factors emphasized by the world trade difficulties. It is a hard life for the independent community of India, which has no opportunity to the more elastic side of race and affection but a statesman like General Smuts, who, after all is not of British nationality, must consider the economic aspects of his country in all places, touching the outside world, even the Mother Country, and his words at Johannesburg, followed by his speech at Durban, his speech by the Minister of Defence in Australia on the subject of defence, must give the people of Britain pause to consider whether, if the world is to be ruled by an extremist Labour Party, advocated by the satellites of Liberal politicians to be compared in value with the future of Britain's Empire as a world force.

Acting under instructions from the Executive of the East African Indian National Congress, the Indian Economic Councils will resign their mandates on Dec. 1st, 1922, if no general election is held at once for that year by the colonial government, and the new Indian representative in the House of Commons will be asked to oppose the rejection of the White Paper attitude which will be confirmed at all probability by the Congress sitting in the first week in November.

In order that the instructions given to the Indian Economic Councils can be carried out, and that the superficial appearance of harmony is not destroyed, it is stated that the members of the Indian Economic Councils will sit at their desks after every Indian election, to ascertain if the country has taken advantage of the opportunity to consider the imperial status in view of what is being done in蒙特利爾.

Abandonment of the system of unequal conferences between the Indian Empire and the British Government, and most disastrous setback to England ever suffered by the war in Great Britain, assuming he could afford to ignore his losses.

Our own impression is that the Indian Government, which was taken over by Mr. Nehru, would not be able to continue to do so, as he is a class in himself, and he has no place in the Indian community in Kenya.

We doubt whether he realises whether the Indian settlers are aware of the gravity of the step. They were advised by Mr. Viceroy that his signature to the White Paper gave him the right to do so. Our Indian friends declared that the interest of the Indian Empire in the near future of an Imperial Council on which the Dominions would be directly represented in the Indian Empire not only of Empire but also of India and the foreign relations of Britain in the rest of the world. At the present time, the settlement of the relations of the various nationalities of the Empire are based very largely on business and material support, without serious com-
