CURRENT TOPICS.

In years gone by there have been many Associations for the furtherance of East African interests in London. They have had various titles. Now we have the East African Chamber of Commerce, the Manchester, Liverpool, Birmingham and Belfast Chambers of Commerce, the Associated Professions, the Corporation, the Associated Chambers of Commerce of Kenya and representatives of the leading East African producer industries. The council is growing.

The fact of the matter is that there are only one or two real ways by which real production in East Africa can be advanced and commercial life can be raised and most obvious is by having an official representative in London, paid by Government like the Agents-General of the self-governing colonies, who would take his own office from that country and act primarily on his own initiative in London, or failing this in the joint name of the Corporation and Associated Chambers of Commerce paid jointly by these bodies. We want in short a genuine or authority representing Kenya interests and in touch with local movement here, and an authority keeping in touch with the other side. The interests of the local agriband merchant and producer are not always identical with Home interests. We want a man, not a committee.

A group in Nyasaland has just established a Home Agency office in the Barkley Road, London, styling themselves The Nyasaland General Agency and Information Bureau. This office is to be a personal enterprise and not a public or official one. It has sent a most attractive illustrated pamphlet, beautifully printed, on art paper. It claims to be representing the pioneer, the opportunist, the investor and producer. It acts as agent and is prepared to deal completely. 




