GOVERNMENT WINS ON SINGAPORE DEBATE.

Conservative Motion Defeated.

GENERAL SHUTS WHOLEHEARTEDLY SUPPORTS ABANDONMENT.

Labour's "Moral Gesture."

SOLIDIFYING LEAGUE OF NATIONS BETTER THAN NEW DOCS.

The Government has scored a victory over the abandonment of the Singapore Bills.

Despite the opposition of the Conservatives as adverse motion was defeated owing to a split in the Liberal ranks.

The Government, anxious to encourage an International Disarmament Conference, desires to make Singapore a "moral gesture" to impress the world and believe wholeheartedly in the League of Nations.

General Scott supports the Government as he believes a "good base is the best way to meet the spirit of Washington."

Colonel Latimer Davies regrets the new policy deeply from the point of view of a naval strategists.

Sir Robert Horne describes the "opportunity" given to the Dominions to state their view as the most disastrous form of obstruction he has ever known.

[TELEGRAPH REPORTER'S REPORT.]

London, March 23.—Official correspondence is reported in the Sunday Times from Sir George Grey, who expresses his whole-hearted support of the Government's white paper, and states that the proposed scheme of disbanding the British Army in India will be carried out in accordance with the wishes of the War Cabinet.

He strongly states that Mr. Scott and Mr. Meany will not be able to prevent the formation of a national army in India.

Mr. Horne emphasizes that the Dominions, Australia and New Zealand (Opposition) should be allowed to remain in the Commonwealth.

He also points out that the Government's decision to send Mr. Horne to India for communication and that it was impossible to do so without leaving the country in general language.

A Moral Gesture.

The Government's decision and points out that the Conservative party had a moderate fear it would be unable to operate effectively.

He also points out that for the protection of the Indian frontier, the forces of the Punjab and Central India were to be placed under command of the Commander-in-Chief of the Indian Ocean.

He further intimates that the Government's decision to abandon the present British Army in India will be carried out in accordance with the wishes of the War Cabinet.

The very existence of the Singapore Bills was intended for defensive purposes and was no more than a protest to Japan's Gibson-Gough Bill.

Colonel Latimer Davies had hoped that the present British Army in India would be reduced to a minimum.

The outcome of the Singapore Bills depends on the Navy. The Admiralty has been asked to make a report on the matter.

General Scott, however, has stated that the Admiralty would be responsible for the safety of the Empire's capital cities in case of war.

Conservative Debate.

In the House of Commons the Conservative party has voted in favour of the Singapore Bills, which moved a resolution.

Colonel Latimer Davies.

The Liberal vote was split.
