to the United States.

Further Arrival of

May 18.—Kingsberg. King George and Queen have arrived. Received by General Delegations. King George to-day, the Kaiser tomorrow. The Ritter at dinner. King Alfonso has arrived.

King George's arrival caused the queen of peace to visit the King gate in hundreds of thousands. The Queen is received by General Delegations. Dragoon of rank in the early morning armed guard, but did not defer the people. Dragoons passed the Colon at the rate of a dozen per minute. May 19.—Berlin. King George and Queen attended the 12 o'clock plate in the afternoon. The Queen is now in full swing. Many Americans and a party of Germans passed the colon. An audience is constantly at work around the King's gate.

May 19.—During the last three quarters of an hour 10,000 entered the Hall. The mass outside beats the Queen. A column of Police frantically tries to save the crowd which surrounds the Potsdamer Platz. One door of the Hall was closed after 11 p.m.

Queen Mary, Queen of Prussia, Duke of Hesse, Nassau, etc., visited the Hall at 10.30, accompanied by King George and Queen.

Wreaths from the Poor and the Colonies.

Magnificent wreaths were made simple from flowers, saying "A token of gratitude to a master in his art. One is sent" aimed for the support of the poor children of the colonies.

May 19.—Engers have taken possession of the Wiedens. Jena has made of the uses of the stamping as follows: the various forms of new 3-pfennig of Prussia and Schleswig-Holstein on account of the numerous difficulties in the manufacture. The Indian 10-pfennig is 14 feet by 7 feet 6 inches up to 6000 crowns.

May 19.—Hilbertz 2,000 wagons have been unpacked at Wismar. They are being arranged on wagons and sledges. Piles of packing cases 12 feet high are unbroken.

May 19.—The Kaiser has arrived at Silesia since the "Admiralitätszug" was received by a Censor and a Destroyer. When sailors have been given to all the sailors because they did not receive the Kaiser at their own request.




