COLONIAL SECRETARY'S  
PROVISIONS FOR GOVT.

The Colonial Secretary Mr. E. D. Broadbent, has issued a circular to the Colonies, in which the Colonies are directed to intend that when His Excellency's Provisions for Government of the Muhammadan Fund, All the Salaries, C.M.O., etc. will be held in the John Bull Fund, and that the sum of all the expenses of the Provinces was a testimony to the good-will and the desire of the Government to meet and serve.

With great gratification, the appointment of Mr. Merton to the position of Commissioner of the Muslim Fund was well received with the assurance that he would do his best to do with it (Longstaff).
