Answer to Indian Committee.

FRIM ON RETENTION OF THE HIGHLANDS

Native Opinion Sought on Indians in Loveland.

[INDIAN COMMITTEE'S AGENT]

London, Aug. 7.

In the House of Commons to-day Mr. J. H. Mills (Lab., Dartford, Kent), asked whether the Secretary of State for the Colonies was in a position to give him information as to what representations recently made to him on certain matters affecting Indians in Kenya by the Indian Committee. Mr. J. H. Thomas, replying, said: "I will take the subject in the order raised by the Committee."

"The first point is that my government has no power to interfere with any of such a nature, of whatever class or race or nationality or character, as may be likely to be prejudicial to the economic interests of the Natives I hold myself entirely free to take any action which may be necessary."

Considering that the matter which have been laid before me not enabled us to reach a definite conclusion in regard to the extent of Indian immigration; consequently, step will be taken to create a Committee to obtain accurate information with regard to the numbers of all Indians arriving in Kenya or departing from Kenya."

"All the time we have had before us a definite conclusion in favour of an Indian census, but I am not prepared to reach the conclusion arrived at in the White Paper of July 1923, that in the special circumstances of Kenya, with its diverse communities, each of which will ultimately require official representation, the communal system is the best way to serve the economic interests of the Natives."

"III. THE HIGHLANDS:—I consider that a Secretary of State for the Colonies has no alternative but to continue the pledge, expressed or implied, which have been given in the past, and no hope of the present policy in regard to agricultural land in the Highlands."

"IV. THE LOWLANDS:—It was proposed to release an area in the Lowlands of Kenya for agricultural immigrants from India. The committee made it plain it is far from any movement of heart for any immigrant race. Subject to that it suggested that before agreeing to any scheme of this kind, every effort should be taken of sending an efficient representative in India to settle and agricultural methods to report on those areas."

"At present any consideration of the matter is in suspense pending the return of the Colony of reports from the native and the agricultural points of view on the areas in question."

### Colonial Disputes.

Colonial Disputes.—Under the heading of "Colonial Disputes," Mr. Gifford, the Secretary of State for the Colonies, said that all countries retain to native peoples the right to determine as to boundaries or any other question, and that the right of self-government is not to be denied to any native community.

The Indian Committee, however, has urged that the right to self-government should be extended to the High Commission Territories.

Native Options Sought on Indians in Lovelands.

[TRADE UNIONISTS' ANSWER]

In the House of Commons to-day Mr. J. R. Mills (Lab., Dartford, Kent), asked whether the Secretary of State for the Colonies was in a position to make a statement to representatives recently made to him on certain matters affecting Indians in Kenya by Mr. G. L. D. Scott (Lab., Merton Park, London), to which "I will take the subjects in the order raised by the Committee."

**I. IMMIGRATION:** My position is that if the danger ever arises of such an influx of immigration, of whatever class or race or national origin, as would threaten the economic and social and economic interests of the Native I hold myself entirely free to take any action which may be necessary.

Conflicting statistics which have been held before me have not enabled me to decide definitely in regard to the extent of Indian immigration. Some steps are being taken by the Statistical Department to obtain reliable information with regard to persons of all races arriving in Kenya or departing from Kenya.

Meanwhile, the Kenya Immigration ordinance will not be made.

**II. FRANCHISE:** I have given careful consideration to representations in favour of a communal poll, but I am not prepared to rule out the committee arrangement at the General Paper 1922 of July 1922, which provided for the franchise of Kenyans, who for diverse communities, each of which will sit in its own constituency, representation, the communal system is the best way to secure the fair representation of each and all these communities.

**III. THE HIGHLANDS:** I consider that a Secretary of State for the Colonies has no alternative but to accept the pledge, expressed or implied, which have been given in the past, and I can hold no hope of the present policy in regard to agriculture, which has been so often promised.

**IV. THE LOWLANDS:** It was my intention to review an area in the Lovelands of Kenya for agricultural immigrants from India. The Committee made it plain that it is open from any viewpoint to any immigrants there. Subject to the fact that the suggested area, being the best land in lowland areas we invited opportunity should be taken of arranging an officer especially in Indian settlement and agricultural methods to report on these areas.

At present my consideration of the matter is in a comparative sense, derived from the Colony of reports from the native and the agricultural points of view on the areas in question.

### British Dispossession.

Under a new agreement the British Government has decided that all matters relating to native titles as to boundaries or any disputes arising out of them shall be dealt with by the Land Commission, unless otherwise ordered. The decision of the Court will be left to High Court and will be observed in due course.

### Native Mortgages.

Under a new agreement certain mortgages will be established in the Indian colonies. In India, Karamoja, Uganda, and Northern Rhodesia, Post Office savings will be used for the purpose.

The following statement sets out the main features of the new scheme:—  
The amount of the loan will be £100,000, or equivalent, and the term 20 years, or equivalent to 40 years.  
Interest will be 5% per annum.  
The loan will be used for the construction of roads, bridges, etc., and for the improvement of irrigation systems.



## THE EAST AFRICAN STANDARD.

### NEW AND DANGEROUS PLANT PEST.

Valuable Expert Hints from  
Uganda.

### ATTACKS UPON COFFEE.

The Uganda Mycologist has  
made a valuable report on a new  
fungus which has been found in Uganda, and on the natural  
method of control of the pest by the  
natural enemy of the plant.

The new Uganda fungus (Elsmeria  
nigra) is a small, dark, brownish  
fungal growth, known to attack the oily oils, the  
stomach, tea, Camellia, ginger, etc., and  
has been found on coffee plants.

This new pest has been found to  
attack coffee plants in the same way  
as the old species of Elsmeria, which  
have been planted as shade-shade in  
the country for many years ago.

At the present point the new  
hosts of the Elsmeria have been  
introduced plants.

In this connection it should be  
noted that the fungus has not been found on indigenous  
plants, such as coffee, tea, ginger, etc., which  
descended from those introduced  
originally from Java in the form  
of seeds.

It is well known that another  
fungus, called the potato blight, which  
was first introduced into this country  
from Europe, has been planted in  
various places, and has actually  
been cultivated in large numbers and  
brought into the market for sale in  
the towns.

The Mycologist thinks  
that the new pest may be  
of little importance in view of the  
knowledge we now have concerning  
the cause of the collapse of African  
coffee.

It must, however, be the case  
that the hosts of the new pest will  
have to be destroyed if the pest  
will have to be regarded as  
one of the most harmful in the  
country.

MEDICAL OFFICER OF HEALTH.

The following statement is given  
by Dr. H. C. Williams, the  
Medical Officer of Health:

"I would like to point out that  
the potato blight, which is a  
fungus, has been planted, and it  
follows me that a storage root, and  
it follows me that the storage root  
of the potato is attacked by the  
potato blight, so long as the root  
and especially to the presence of  
the blight, and it follows me that  
overripe material.

"It was also proved that the  
Fusarium, which is a plant, did  
not penetrate the unbroken  
skin of the potato, but that  
when the skin was broken, the  
spores of Fusarium were found  
in association with a white mass  
of fungi, which was probably  
overripe material.

"It was also proved that  
the blight does not penetrate  
the skin of the bean, but that  
when the skin is broken, the  
spores of the blight are  
present, and they do not  
penetrate the bean, but that  
they are destructive only under  
certain conditions.

"It was also proved that  
the presence of even a well  
ripened bean, which is  
damaged, may cause the  
presence of the blight in  
the case of the bean.

"The heat and disease-reacting  
agents, which are present in  
these environments, to a greater  
extent than those of human beings,  
are the cause of the disease in  
the environment when it is unhygienic  
or when there is no care taken  
to do so.

It is therefore, the responsibility  
of the planter or cultivator to ensure  
that his beans are grown in  
possible surroundings for his  
beans, and where they are  
grown, where they are stored.
