COLLEGE OF TROPICAL AGRICULTURE.

Big Imperial Scheme at Trinidad.

LORD MILNER EXPLAINS.

London, June 25.

For a further explanation of the scheme for the establishment of a College of Tropical Agriculture in Trinidad, Lord Milner has explained in the House of Commons.

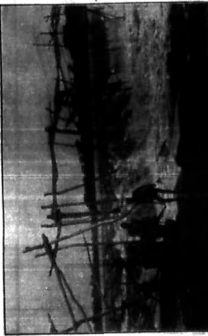
