There are three basic physical properties which determine the value of a lubricating oil. These are: viscosity, volatility, and stability. Viscosity is the resistance to flow, and is the most important property. It is determined by the temperature and the nature of the oil. Volatility is the tendency of an oil to evaporate, and is determined by the boiling point of the oil. Stability is the ability of an oil to resist oxidation and other chemical changes, and is determined by the nature of the oil and the conditions of use.
