THE ROYAL VISIT.

Nairobi Town Commissioners displayed their innate conservatism on Tuesday when they declined to order further committal proposals that would result in a roped off square at Nairobi Railway Station be reserved at a price of £1 each. If the Council decide against any such innovation they will display a sense of the proper fitness of things in keeping with the same traditions of the draft Nairobi programme we published this week.

Whatever may be the attitude of other authorities in other hands some responsibility for the arrangement of the programme of the visit lies, the people of Nairobi would not desire to see their own representatives on the Municipal Council parties to class distinction and segregation on a basis of twenty paddy shillings. We hope that in Kenya we are sufficiently democratic to decline against any proposal which treats the Royal Visitors like a common side-show and provides rigid seats, at a price for the gratification of vulgar curiosity. In plain language, that is what the suggestion means in the minds of the public and we would not feel at all comfortable in our own minds were our visitors' first impressions of the Capital of Kenya to be a roped off space with the site inside and the "common herd" outside. We do not think it is the business of any public body to arrange a public welcome on these terms and if it is necessary to assist in control of the traffic that there should be erected a special stand at the station, we hope the Council will show sufficient politeness to erect it for the benefit of the ladies of the town who will feel very kindly the agonies of waiting for any length of time in the heat of December.

We are entirely opposed to anything which creates social distinctions either in the form of a payment for a reserved seat or through a ticket system which places the power of selection in any official hands and, in the interests of the good sense of the community, we appeal to the Council to depart from any scheme which, in effect, turns a spontaneous welcome into an elaborately staged managed side show. The Duke and Duchess of York, being ordinary human beings on a holiday, do not want any introduction to the social distinctions and peculiarities which still persist in Nairobi and the retailers will be much more happy if the Council presents its bill to the community after the work is done than if the City Fathers try a money-making scheme to cut the cost. The idea of any reserved seating in a public reception is the worst that can be the good intentions of the Council.

Mr. Gandhi's Peacemaking.

Lord Reading has informed Mr. Gandhi permission to visit Kohat, where Mr. Gandhi intended to proceed with Muslim Friends in order to restore neighbourly relations between Hindus and Muslims.

FRIDAY'S CABLES.

AWARD BETWEEN TURKEY AND BRITAIN.

League Council Fixes Iraq Boundary.

TURKS LOSE THEIR CLAIM.

(TURKISH SERVICE'S AGENCY.)
Brussels, Oct. 30.
The decision of the Council of the League of Nations to whom the question of the status quo in the Taurus Iraq frontier was referred by Britain, constitutes a line whereby the British gave up the administration of a small tract but do not encroach any of the area claimed, while the Turks renounce some villages.
We strategically important place is affected on either side. Both parties have agreed to accept the decision.
A neutral Commissioner and three members headed by Count Tsechik, the ex-Turkish Premier will proceed to Mosul at the earliest possible date to finally settle the frontier where in this provisional line there is no relation.

A clerk named Joseph J. Gattor was charged at Dublin today with conspiracy to murder Private Ansell, a British soldier, in the matter of the seven Dublin arrests yesterday. He was stated to have committed five of the men mentioned in the murder charge yesterday as provided for Quantavara for the purpose of the murder.
The accused man replied that the charge was ridiculous. He was remanded until November 4.

The Flight to Java.

Amsterdam, Oct. 30.
According to newspaper reports, a new Holland-Borneo engine has arrived at Philadelphia to repair damage suffered by the former engine in the flight to Java.
It is expected that the flight will be resumed on Saturday to Canton, Michigan.

FRENCH TERMS TO THE SOVIET.

Obligations of Freedom to be Recognized.

RUSSIAN AGREEMENT.

(FRANCO-AMERICAN AGENCY.)
Paris, Oct. 30.

The French Note to Russia recognizing the Soviet stipulation that the recognition will in no way infringe any undertaking entered into by France. It also expressly reserves the rights of the French Government and assumes responsibility for the obligations of former Russian regimes.

Finally, the Note insists on mutual non-interference with the other's internal affairs.
The Russian Government's reply expresses the hope that all the questions mentioned in the French Note will be satisfactorily settled by the forthcoming negotiations, and welcomes the French declaration with regard to internal non-interference.

WAHABIS REFUSE PEACE OFFERS.

Jeddah Preparing to Fight.

Riyadh, Oct. 29.

An attempt by leading members of Jeddah and Mecca to arrange terms with the Wahabis has failed. The representatives of the Wahabis in Mecca refuse any peace is impossible while Amir Ali remains in the Hijaz. This appears to be the inevitable result.

Jeddah is now closed in a state of blockade and the Wahabis are being made to resist the British attack and reinforcements are coming from Jeddah, Mecca, and other parts of the peninsula.
