### CLEARING ELEPHANT IN TANGANYIKA.

#### Official Hunter Meets with an Adventure.

##### AS RETOLD AT HOME

A Hampshire man, Mr. Murray Smith, gives an idea of the official destruction of elephant in Tanganyika, as seen by four hunters engaged to serve the dependence of making more spacious invasions.

According to "The Hampshire Advertiser," which reports an interview with him on his return home, he spent nine months in the bush and his life was not easy.

The Hampshire newspaper is amazingly hazy concerning East Africa (sharing that innocence with the rest of the Press), generally when it comes to hunting, it makes the reader start up-country to Nairobi to shoot buffaloes and talk of shambas as 14 feet high, but all in all its gets through its interview quite steadily.

"I have been hunting twice the size of Wales," said Mr. Murray Smith, "to hunt over on my own, and to kill as many elephants as I could."

And here is a little addition: "I shot a wounded elephant while following a wounded bear through grass," said "Fool-dey," he related, "we had our gunning mount out of the bush within ten yards of us. Although

"At that moment my native gun-hunter came up and shot the elephant in the side.

It was only a light gun, but it seemed to shock him, for he lay suddenly down, then struggled to his feet again, but was soon down again. The shot made him pause, then straightened himself, and he went over into the bush.

THE HUNTER'S EXPERTISE OF THE ELEPHANT as a soldier had lit up for three weeks at a mission station to which his boy carried him. Through follow-up of his tracks, he followed the trail of his prey where except in the "face," the elephant that had sustained the black eye was nevermore seen.

Only the hunter got a handful of his tusks, but he had a hole in the side of his neck, and when he was hit he lay dead.

He describes a more exciting adventure: "I went up a tree for about two hours, but when I could get in a shot," he said, "and unfortunately a shot of sorts had been chosen the same tree for their shade, and they swarmed all over me. This elephant fell to a single shot."



It may be long after that one can only conjecture. If the Forest Department do not act now the Kilimayi to carry on the programme will be greater in scope.

A few weeks ago my losses during the last year a large amount of fruit was lost due to being eaten by monkeys and native huts, and day after day we were told that the destruction of what must have been thousands of trees is of no great use to man.

Every lover of nature must resent the removal of forest growth that is not needed. We must all endeavor to one to ask what each of us can do to help to save our forest and planting it again. We must all do our best to spread limited knowledge there are hundreds of miles worth a few million dollars of fruit and vegetables lost in the forest reserve which could be used to feed the people in great cost, or waste.
