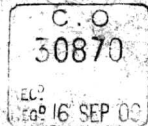

In this matter I am assuming that Mr. Bebb temporarily takes Mr. Hiden's place, that the owner Assistant is the extra one asked for in my No.46/191 of the 30th September 1908 and Mr. J.A. Barnes' No.7/30/2 of January 28th 1909 and that £ of Mr. Hiden's pay while serving in Scotland is debitable to the East Africa Protectorate. I would ask if Mr. Knollys has now been permanently transferred to Uganda. Under the present arrangement he is supposed to do six months there and six months in the East Africa Protectorate. He left for Uganda on the 23rd October last returning to Nairobi on the 24th June and left again in response to your telegram of the 15th July on the 23rd idem.

I would respectfully urge the necessity of the appointment of the two new clerks asked for

as in addition to the normal increase of work both in the Railway and Protectorate accounts it has been found necessary to open a separate branch office at Mombasa. (The Head Office having been transferred to Nairobi) also the expenditure accounts in Zanzibar are heavier than was expected.

It will be remembered when the system of local audit of expenditure for the East Africa Protectorate was approved, two clerks <sup>only</sup> of Rs.125 p.m. were allowed for the work. Since then the expenditure audit of Zanzibar has been undertaken with no increase in the clerical staff, a provident fund has been started on the Railway which is increasing very rapidly and has to be checked in great detail as it partakes more or less of the nature of a savings bank and occupies the sole attention of one clerk for at least four days, and the catering on the Uganda Railway and Lake Steamers which was formerly operated out by a contractor has been taken over directly and requires very careful checking. The increments

to the clerical staff are in accordance with His  
Excellency's Circular of November 24th 1908. 520
