Paraphrase of Telegram from Lord H. Hervey to Sir E. Grey, No.3. dated January 27th, 1909.

Southern frontier inspector.

With reference to my telegram No.1 of January 6th, I have heard from Major Gwynne that he intends to take the Inspector with him to Lake Rudolph. In case the grant is not renewed, it must be realized that it will be impossible to withdraw Mr. Zaphiro for several months in view of the difficulties of communication. His retention both for the present and also for the new scheme later on is urged by Major Gwynne.
