Paraphrase of telegram from Lord H. Hervey to Sir E. Grey, No. 12, undated.

Southern Frontier. With reference to my immediately preceding telegram.

I have received a further message from Mr. Zaphiro stating that he intends to remain on the Frontier to watch a large body of Abyssinian troops that has been sent to capture raiders and elephant hunters.

Am I authorized to instruct Mr. Zaphiro to return if the troops have left the Frontier, as in Major Gwynne's opinion it is advisable that he should meet him here about the end of April to discuss state of things?
