

Land Grants made "A" 152.

- " - pending "B" 456.

- " - cancelled "C" 46.

The figures under "B" are explained by Mr. Barton Wright whose analysis shews the different stages to which the pending cases have reached.

2. I have examined some of the files of the pending cases, and have found that in the majority no fault lies with either the Land or Survey Department for the delay in completion.

But a few records show that in some instances cases have been lost sight of, and have not been pushed along with all possible speed.

I have instructed the Land Officer to go carefully over the files of every pending case between this and the end of the current half year, so that, if possible, a further reduction may be made in the pending cases.

3. I have come to the conclusion that it is unnecessary to show as incomplete the cases which appear as "pending registration".

In the early days we used to have the deeds registered for the grantees. But seeing that the registration of deeds of immovable property is the business of the grantees, not of the grantor, we now send the completed deed to the purchaser or lessee and inform him that he must register within a fixed time, otherwise he will be liable to the payment of a penalty in the Registration Office.

The

The deed cannot be accepted in Court unless registered and it is for the grantee to take steps to make his title good.

I propose, therefore, to eliminate from future returns all cases now shown as "pending registration".

So far as the Land Office is concerned the transaction is complete when the deed has been made over.

4. For the rest, it is only necessary to enumerate some of the causes of delay in the completion of our land cases.

(a) Missionary Societies have asked for plots in isolated positions, and it has not been possible yet to send surveyors to prepare the plans.

No licensed surveyor will undertake to do such work at the current rates.

(b) Applications have been made and accepted for land in the Sultan's Dominions but the grants cannot be completed until the rights in land have been decided.

(c) Names have been registered for land in certain localities which have not been blocked out into farms.

(d) Draft or completed deeds which have been sent to grantees for approval or signature have been kept an unduly long time.

5. The registration of names under head "c" has now ceased. Our rule is to entertain no application until land has been surveyed and plans prepared.

But we still have a number of cases in which land has been promised in some area in the hope that such

locality

locality will be opened to settlement.

Persons sometimes put in their applications and leave the country, and time is taken in ascertaining if they wish their applications to stand.

As to (d) we now warn persons that if deeds are not returned quickly the grants will be cancelled.
