Sir,

I am directed by the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that They have received from the Foreign Office an application for the award of pension to Mr. John Robert Wilson Pigott, His Majesty's Consul for Surinam and Cayenne who, having attained the age of 60, will retire as from the 4th September next inclusive.

Mr. Pigott is stated to have served as Sub Commissioner in the British East Africa Protectorate from 1st July 1895 to March 5th 1896 at a salary of £600 a year.

My Lords would be glad to be informed whether Mr. Pigott is entitled to pension in respect of all or part of his service in British East Africa and, if so, whether the Secretary of State agrees that his case, like that of Mr. G. B. Pigott (vide Treasury letter of 31st March 1910 - 5437/10), may be dealt with under the Superannuation Act, 1892.
