- 4. I am to request that you will state whether you accept this offer, and, if so, that you will inform me whether you would be prepared to leave for East Arica by the Union Castle steamer which starts from Marseilles on the ord of Warch. That is the first available steamer by which you could travel, and, in the event of your being able to leave them, it would be necessary for you to have your heavy backage ready for shipment at Southempton some ten days before the steamer is due to leave Marseilles. You will be provided with a free lat class passage to the Protectorate, and you will draw half salary from the date of leaving England and full salary from the date of arrival at Mombass.
