With reference to your telegram of the 11th instant, I have the honour to transmit herewith a Statement showing the distribution of the European and Indian Medical Staff throughout the Protectorate.

2. You will observe that a Medical Officer or Subordinate has been posted to all stations where detachments of troops are quartered, with the exception of Moyale. The Medical Officer, Northern Frontier District, divides his time between Marsabit and Moyale and in case of serious trouble he would be with the troops.

3. In the event of troops being despatched to a locality where medical aid is not readily obtainable arrangements are always made for a Medical Officer or Subordinate to accompany the detachment.
