Sir,

With reference to Rule No 27 of the Colonial Audit Regulations (Revised April 1903) I am directed by the Comptroller and Auditor General to request that you will lay before the Secretary of State the accompanying estimate of the amount which will be required for the cost of the audit of the Accounts of the East Africa Protectorate for the year 1906-1907.

2. In this estimate provision has been included for the pay of an additional clerk, at Rs. 75 a month, and for one half of the pay of a clerk, at the same rate, whose services and salary, the Local Auditor proposes, shall be divided equally between the East Africa Protectorate and the Uganda Railway.

This increase in the subordinate staff has been recommended by the Local Auditor who reports that the audit work, both on the Protectorate and Railway accounts, is increasing in volume, necessitating the extra assistance now
