



As directed by the Board, I have the honor to refer your letter (from this Department to No. 179, of the 2nd ult., reporting the arrival in this country of Mr. E. S. Barnes, the Local Auditor of the East Africa Protectorate, and to acquaint you, for the information of Mr. Secretary Lyttelton, that a telegram was received from the Acting Local Auditor at Mombasa of the 20th inst., to the effect that the Medical Officer insisted on Mr. van de Velde, <sup>one</sup> of the Assistant Auditors, proceeding on leave of absence on the 29th instant, instead of remaining in the Protectorate, as had been arranged, until February next.

The Senior Audit Clerk, Mr. P. Vaz, is also understood to be absent from Mombasa, as, after a service of over six years without leave, he has been granted four months leave of absence to commence in the present month and Mr. Hanson, the Assistant Auditor in Uganda - who otherwise might have been available for East Africa - is also returning home on leave.

2. As in addition, the ordinary duties of the Local Audit Department in East Africa it will be necessary directly to provide for the usual visit of the Auditor, one of the Assistant Auditors of the East Africa Protectorate, to Mombasa, the Controller and General Officer in Charge, in order that the Department should not fall into arrears to date.
