Sir,

I have the honour to refer to your telegram dated the 8th of July 1915 approving the expenditure of £2000 on the establishment of four posts in the Turkana District, to be met from the proceeds of the sale of the stock captured during the operations against the tribe.

2. The Provincial Commissioner has recently reported that a further sum of £600 will be required to complete the work in a satisfactory manner, the excess over the original estimate being caused by transport charges, increase in rise of prices, and cement for making concrete floors in the buildings already erected. In this sum was also included the erection of two suspension bridges and quarters for the Sub-Assistant Surgeon.

3. I have accordingly sanctioned the issue of a Special Warrant for £300 to defray the cost of such work as is absolutely necessary for

for the completion of the existing buildings and laying down concrete floors. This amount will be met from the proceeds of the sale of captured stock, but the question of suspension bridges and quarters for the Sub-Assistant Surgeon will be deferred until the account is finally made up.
