At the time of his deatth, Captain Isaacson was filling the appointment of Staff Captain to the LIBDI Celumn. He took a cart in the operations on the lote, lith June, which resulted in ofearing the MENERA vicinity, is the LIBDI aros, of the enemy. During the operations on the lith the enemy heavily attacked the Head Quarters of the Coglumn and the 25th Battalion of the Royal Fueliters, who were halted awaiting evmohronising mevements of other units. The situation looked a little critical at one time and I asked Captain Isaacson to initiate a counter attack against the enemys left flank. It was while accompanying

this attack that he received the wound from which he died that same evening at about 8 p.m.

He was shot by a rifle bullet through boths thighe, the femeral artery of the right leg being either severed or badd's injured.
