The whole question, which will include the particular difficulty in which the military authorities are involved, has now been taken up with the Treasury (On Administrator /38281/German East Africa). As the military authorities are concerned, it will be as well for the War Office to be represented at any conference that may take place. We had better send them, with reference to our letter of the 1st August on 37898, a copy of this telegram and copies of Administrator/38281 and of our letter to the Treasury on that paper, and ask whether, if a conference with the Banks can be arranged, they will be willing to send a War Office representative to it.

Commanding has not forwarded to War Office East
African Pay Corps letter May 23rd but Pay Corps
has given copy of letter to National Bank of India
Nairobi which has sent it their London Office.
Suggest consultation between Colonial Office and
War Office and London Office National Bank of India
last of whom able to explain position fully.
