I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th
April 1922 concerning the territorial readjustments to
be made in accordance with the Treaty of London of
1912 which may affect Jubaland and the
territory of the Sultan of Zanzibar.

I am glad to hear that you are with pleasure
convinced that the line indicated in
the map of the Sultan of Zanzibar of March 9th
1922 is a fair and equitable one for the territory
of the Sultan of Zanzibar. I am glad to hear that in the actual
delimitation of the territory the line
is a fair and equitable one and will be found to be
equitable and reasonable in all the
circumstances and considerations of a fair and equitable
delimitation.

With regard to the borders of Somaliland and Egypt
I am glad to note that you are of the opinion that the line of
delimitation

I beg to thank you for your letter of the 10th April with reference to the territorial readjustments to give effect to Article 13 of the Treaty of London of April 26th, 1912, so far as they affect Jubaland and the border of Sudan and Egypt.

With regard to Jubaland I note with pleasure that you are prepared to accept the line indicated in the map annexed to Mr Sparling's letters of March 9th and 10th to Signor Baccari as the border of the territory to be ceded to Italy. I quite agree that in the actual delimitation of the border on the basis of this line - to effect which the two Governments will no doubt appoint a Joint Commission - regard should be paid to local conditions and considerations of administrative convenience.

With regard to the borders of Grenada and Egypt I am also glad to hear that you agree that the line of demarcation should start from a point on the coast about 10 kilometers

14 kilometres north of Soltau and should in other respects
conform to the general plan and chart annexed to Mr. Spaulding's
letter to Senator Baccari of February 28th.

I entirely share your hope that the territorial
points in issue having thus been disposed of, no difficulty
will arise in settling any other questions which have
formed the subject of discussion between our two Governments,
and which have since been agreed that the basis of
our agreement about the boundary can only become effective
as part of the general settlement of all the claims raised
at the Peace Conference.

Thanking you for the information which you have good-
will for me in characterizing your account of these negotiations,

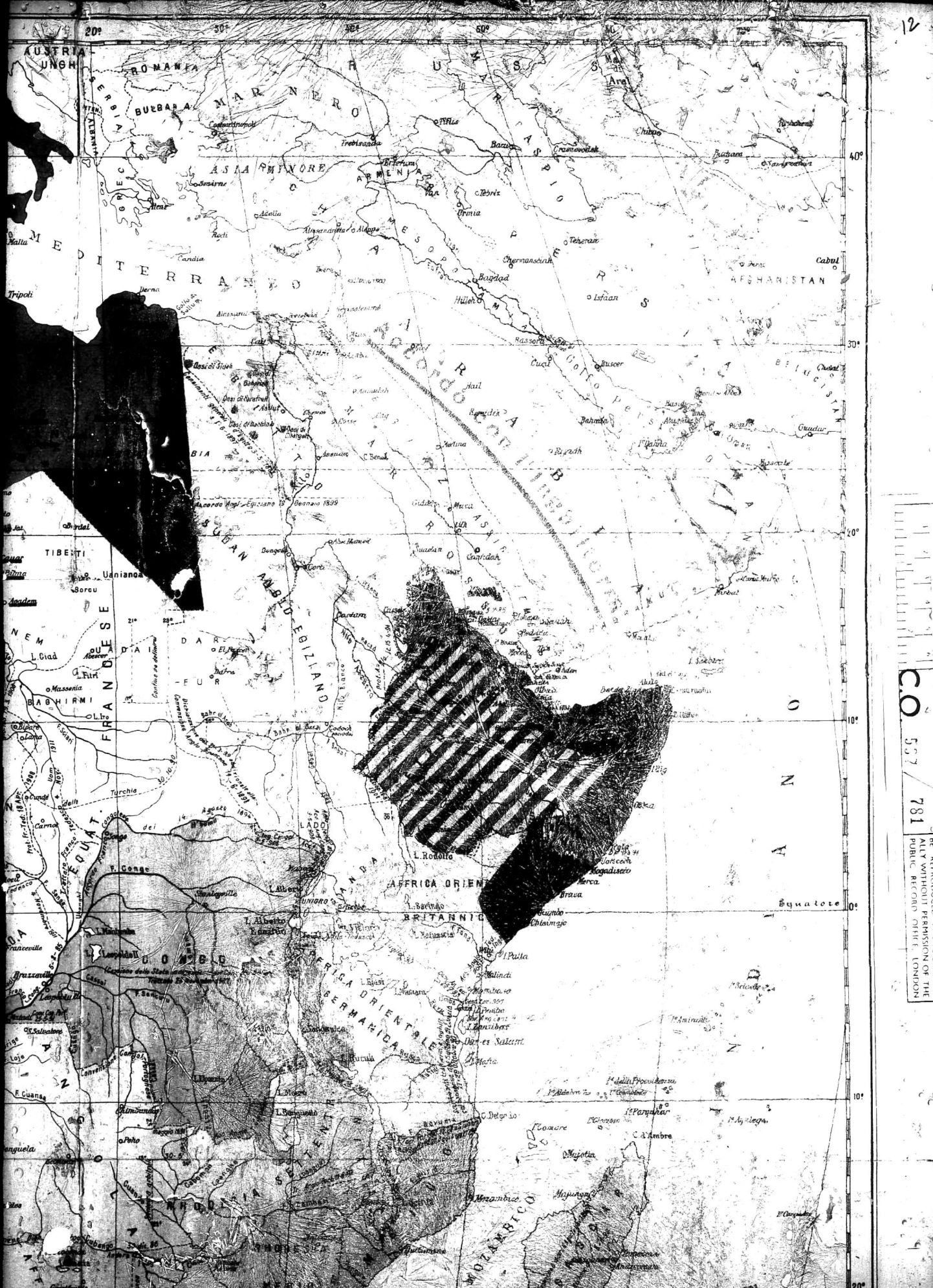

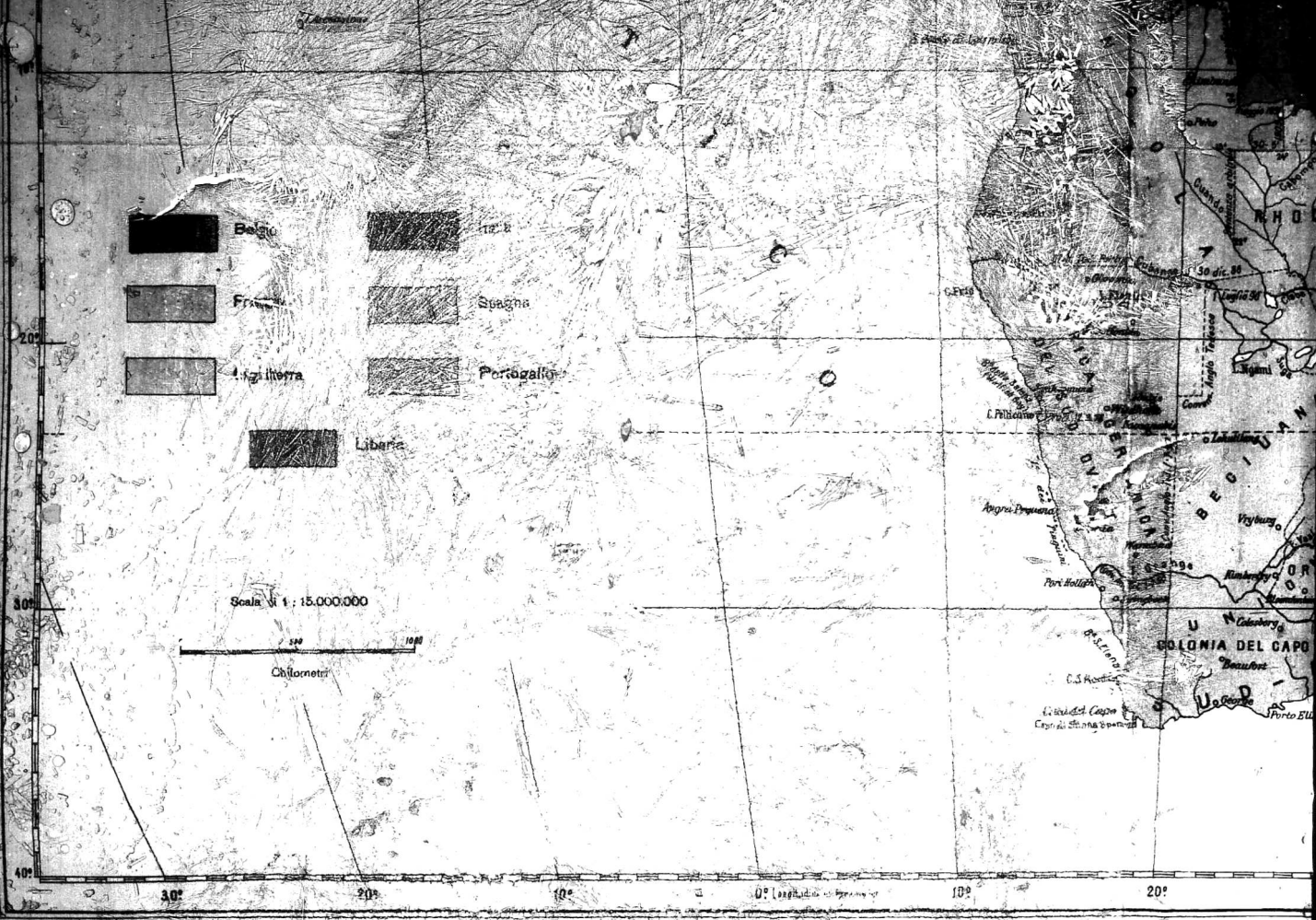
