EXTENSIVE MOVEMENT OF TROOPS IN BRITAIN Parachute brigade embarks on carrier COL. NASSER DRAFTING PLAN TO SETTLE CRISIS

BRITAIN stepped up military preparations at the weekend in face of the Suez crisis and the War Office announced that the precautionary measures being taken necessitated an 'extensive movement of troops.'

As Western officials word on the details of the plan they are to submit to the Suez Canal Commission in London on August 16, the War Office disclosed that Regular soldiers whose period of service is due to expire in the immediate future are to be retained in the Army. It added that the emergency troop movements might also delay the return home of National Servicemen whose time had expired.

Queen Mother's message

Britain's 'Red Devil'—the 16th Independent Parachute Brigade—embarked on the aircraft carrier Theseus at Portsmouth yesterday for their departure to the Mediterranean. The Queen Mother, who is Colonel-in-Chief of the Royal Army Medical Corps, sent a telegram to the ambulance men in the brigade. The Theseus and another aircraft carrier, the Bulwark, were expected to sail last night. The troops were crammed with jeeps, lorries, ammunition trucks and Red Cross vehicles.

While military and naval preparations went ahead, it was understood that on the diplomatic level, Britain, France and the United States will probably propose a planned 24-nation conference a two-tier international organization to run the key economic and social organization, it is believed, would include an international authority which would be responsible for the day-to-day working of the canal.

President Nasser is reported to be drafting proposals to settle the Suez crisis. Diplomatic observers believe he will reject the invitation to attend the London conference but that he will suggest the holding of a conference in Cairo or Constantinople at which he will be prepared to give the fullest guarantee of freedom of navigation through the canal.

The American Secretary of State, Mr. Dulles, said in a radio address in Washington that he returns from the 'Big Three' talks in London that Egypt should be allowed to exploit the Suez Canal for 'its wholly legitimate needs.' He said that if Egypt's attitude of the canal was presented as a 'major international issue' would 'pose a breakdown of the international fabric upon which the world order rests.'


