# U.N. TELLS RUSSIA: HALT ATTACK ON HUNGARY

## 'Allow observers' in request

**OVERWHELMING** support was given by the United Nations General Assembly to a United States resolution calling on Russia to halt its armed attack on Hungary. 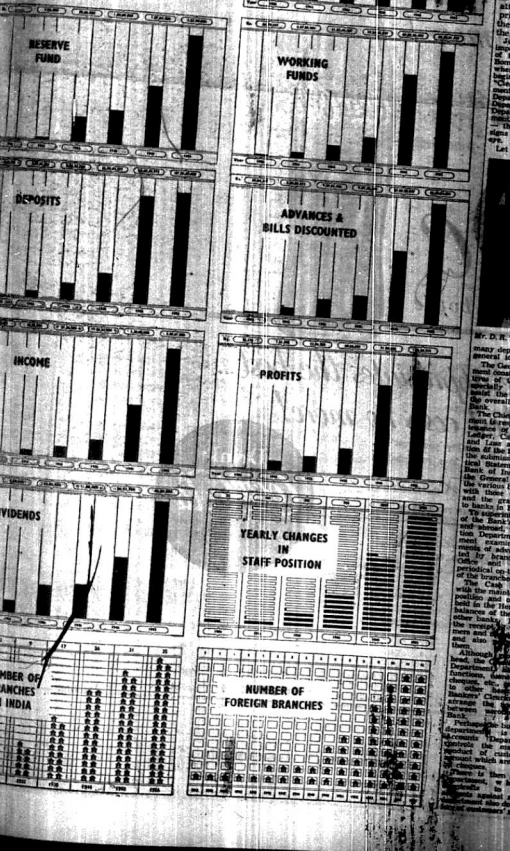
