# REACTANCE IN SUMMIT TALKS White House agrees at last moment BRITISH PROPOSALS

AGREEMENT between the three Western powers on what attitude should be adopted by Mr. Khrushchev's proposal for a summit meeting with Britain and France. It was believed to have occurred yesterday, the House of Commons yesterday, the Secretary, Mr. Selwyn Lloyd, said in a meeting of the Security Council, at which resolutions put forward would be those of the day.

Mr. Lloyd was speaking, a White House spokesman said, and the United States had not yet reached an agreement with Britain and France on the terms of their summit meeting. Mr. Khrushchev's proposal for a summit meeting was "crucially desired" and "it is the hope of the White House that an interim reply had been given to Mr. Khrushchev and a further reply containing suggestions on a summit meeting would be sent to the Secretary of State in the immediate objective of the summit meeting."

Mr. Selwyn Lloyd said that the British Government would be a settlement over the Lebanon and Syria issues. There was a "strong feeling" between the three powers to "bring to a head" the Government's policy, a practical method where "the Government might start along a path which might lead to a greater degree of peace and security in the area as a whole than at present might think feasible."

# U.S. will attend Baghdad Pact talks

DULLES, U.S. Secretary of State, is to go to London next week to attend the meeting of the Ministers of the Baghdad Pact. It was announced in Washington. Latest pronouncements from the State Department make it almost certain that an Iraqi representative will not attend. Withdrawal from the pact is implicit in the report by the Vice-Premier, Col. Abd Arif, that his Government will follow a neutralist policy.

However, the old air-raid alarm sounded instead of the normal curfew signal of "All clear" bringing people rushing into the streets. But police footposts were seen barring out "Forty-eight hour curfew" and the voices of British troops called out "Get inside."

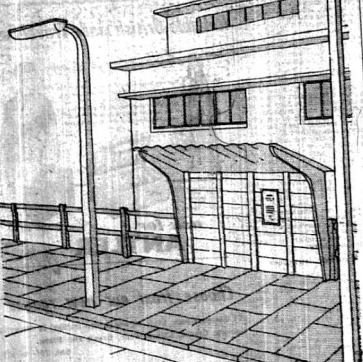

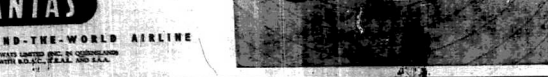

# MACMILLAN FOR TALKS AT SUMMIT

## Notes reveal policy differences

These differences were revealed by the latest letters sent by Mr. Macmillan and President Eisenhower to the Soviet Prime Minister, Mr. Khrushchev, Mr. Macmillan, in his letter, said that he would be ready to go to New York for a meeting of the Security Council on Middle East problems, and that permanent representatives at the United Nations should begin preparations for such a meeting "without delay."

On the eve of Mr. Dulles's flight to London, to meet British leaders and attend the Ministerial Council of the Baghdad Pact, Washington observers said that President Eisenhower's cautious approach to a "summit" meeting would have the backing of the country. It was felt that "it was right to refrain from making any announcement to agree to conditions which would mean that the United States and Britain would be put in the position of performing."

# BLANKETS IN JULY - BUT THEY'VE BEEN COOLER

**Low minimum figures**

Minimum temperatures these mornings lower than in July last year, making Nairobi residents shiver. The average for the first seven days of the month was 51.6 deg. F. and the lowest was 41 deg. F. Although the average maximum temperature has been slightly above normal at this time of year, it nevertheless shows a drop of about two degrees compared with 1937 and 1938. Yesterday, exceptionally heavy cloud and drizzle threatened to bring the temperature to its lowest maximum—50 deg. F.—this month, for by mid-day the thermometer had fallen to 53 deg. F. and by 5 p.m. only two degrees from the cold could be recorded. A heavy shower later in the evening took it to 48 deg. F. This meant that the dew-point temperature was less than the air temperature. The thermometer was taken in the open at 5 p.m. on the 16th and the reading was 48 deg. F. The lowest reading was 43 deg. F. on the 17th.
