JUST ANOTHER CHAPTER

AT SATURDAY, MAY 19, 1945. We are, indeed, an admirably unadministrative community in East Africa, or, we are abnormally illiterate, or we are fast after four years of war we have lost such imagination and power of reaction as to once possessed. But whatever the reason, it should be on the record as a historical fact that not even a single official flag was specially hoisted in the Territories, save for our information at present goes, to mark the fact, not unimportant to the world at large and certainly of some importance to British East Africa, that the Continent of these Territories are a part has been freed from the yoke of slavery and the threat of war. For us, here in Africa, the task is to make even better use of our own guaranteed security by organising still more completely our own defence on a hundred per cent basis. While there is a need for explaining to the African people in particular what the news from Tunisia means in terms of a great Allied victory, and how closely it is related to their own freedom from the three years' threat of aggression by an enemy who had made no attempt to disguise his feelings of Africans as little more than slave labour with few, if any, human rights, it should be felt with a special qualification. The qualification is that victory in Tunisia is not the end of the war. Africa has merely been the stepping stone. Victory is nearer but it may yet be years away. What face the victory means is that the responsibility resting upon all the people of Africa is a still greater portion of the war materials of war, to save still more by making more sacrifices and by seeking new and better ways in which to become still greater and our opportunities more and not less. And that applies as well to war in Europe. We may well have a still more direct contribution to make as victors in Africa theatres. We have done well in Africa, but we have done much more so far.

It is our duty to be more than a passive recipient of the news that the Allied attack has been closely coordinated with the plans of General Patton's victorious campaign. This summer we shall see grand strategy emerge as a nearly unified plan of attack and co-ordination, awe-inspiring and tremendous, whose inspired conclusion is a determination to hasten the end.

THE VEGETABLE PATCH:

Cauliflower, Cabbage And Sprouts

At a time when everybody with any spare land is trying to help in the production of vegetables, it is as well to study a method of propagation other than by seed.

It is obvious that, owing to slipping seasons, it is not possible to grow all the vegetables in the immediate future so the Department of Agriculture has issued instructions for the production of vegetable seed from the most reliable source, that is, the seedling. This is done before any considerable quantities can be raised, and the seedling is then sown in the open ground on a minimum of space.

Propagation of cauliflowers by cuttings is a practice that should be vigorously encouraged. Healthy good seedlings are available or can be raised from the most reliable source, that is, the seedling. 

Narok and Pesi Swamps Drainage Scheme

THE problem of water supplies for those farmers and tribesmen who depend upon the water system of the Upper Nyiro River has long been a matter of concern. A plan to afford a better water supply for some of these, particularly those watered by the Pesi and Narok Rivers, tributaries of the Upper Nyiro, was started on October 27, last year.

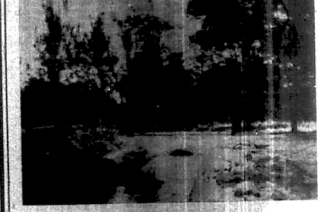
Each of these two rivers, which originates in the highlands of the Uasin Nyiro, passes through a large swamp in the lower reaches of the Narok. The Pesi Swamp is 4 1/2 miles long and almost a mile wide at its widest point, while the Narok Swamp is long and narrow, winding along the left bank of the Narok Swamp involving 1 1/2 million acres of land.



The Prisoners of War have turned out excellent draughts from the various structures. The bridges across the channels are equipped with the chains and wire in stone. The channels were opened temporarily on 19th April to provide water for the Lower Narok which was then dry.

Excavation in the Pesi Swamp has recently been started. In addition to the excavation and masonry works, the Prisoners of War provide many of the materials required. For instance all the rails have been made either from scrap or from wire. The carpenter out for receding the work carried out for each stage and for the production of working sketches and drawings is manufactured in the camp from paper, tools and tiles are being burnt.

Working from centre pegs and a schedule of levels prepared by the Public Works Department, the Prisoners of War have set out the ground and have dug the trial channels behind the main channels. The work is checked on each gang. The work is checked and measured up weekly and a certificate of the number of banks completed is then prepared.



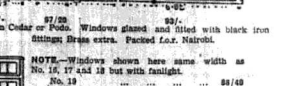
