"The only local experts the High Commission could have appointed would have been members of the Transport Administration, the Kenya Carriage Advisory Corps Services, because, in fact, they are the only people who are technically competent to understand and advise on such matters," said Mr. Thornley.

Both Mr. Sater and Mr. Hilder had avoided giving any details of the need for an inquiry of the kind suggested. Surely if the Council was invited to set up a committee of inquiry it should be told what were the circumstances under which they were asked to reach the decision.

It had been suggested that what was required was a fact-finding inquiry, but it had been pointed out that the opportunity to study that the problem facing the Administration was not that of knowing what were the right and proper solutions.




