Three surviving Third Division clubs in the F.A. Cup competition—Swindon, Leyton Orient and Southend—were knocked out in the first round which was expected to form on Saturday.

Swindon, the holders, however, were lucky to hold on to a one goal lead against Swansea, to go into the next round and continue their bid to become the first club this century to win the Cup two years in succession.

Second Division Swansea staged again and again after the interval, but the methodical Newcastle had on their hands had scored 11 goals in the previous seven.

Cup favourites Arsenal on the other hand were never at full strength in ending the gallant run of Third Division Leyton Orient with a comfortable 5-0 victory. A second round 20,000 crowd watched the match.

The other top third-division sides, Plymouth Town and Southend United, both failed to get their carry-overs against senior competition.

Newcastle and Arsenal were drawn in the quarter-finals by Swindon and Portsmouth of the First Division, and three Second Division clubs, Blackburn Rovers, Luton Town and Sheffield Wednesday.

Chelsea (First Division) and Leeds United (Second Division) drew 1-1 and will play. Chelsea's ground on Wednesday.
