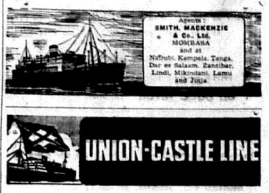

PLAN TO REORGANISE KENYA SOCCER

A SCHEME for a complete reorganisation of the control and governance of soccer in Kenya was presented to the annual general meeting of the Football Association of Kenya at its annual meeting held at the Kenya Club on Saturday last.

—but Income Tax easier

MR. BUTLER ANNOUNCES LEVY ON EXCESS PROFITS

INTRODUCING a Budget which showed that Britain was to cut luxury imports and pay more for its food—without a reduction in food subsidies—Mr. R. A. Butler, Chancellor of the Exchequer, told the House of Commons last night that there would be compensations.

The reduction of food subsidies to £255 million a year by a cut of £160 million will mean a rise in a year's range of food prices, including those of meat, bread, flour, milk, butter, bacon, cheese and sugar. Mr. Butler declared, "There will be a 50c. difference in various parts of Britain. There are no changes in tobacco or liquor taxation."

Most comment favourable CURBING OF CREDIT SEEN AS VITAL POINT

VERY few people in Britain can expect that when the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. R. Butler, sat down after his Budget speech he would have been better off than they had been when he stood. The risks he gave were designed to increase incentives and were arranged to prevent real hardship. But whether he put enough of a pill into the sugar did out for itself in the months ahead, writes Richard Demary, of The Economist.

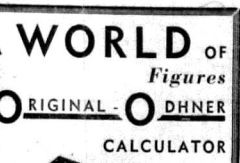

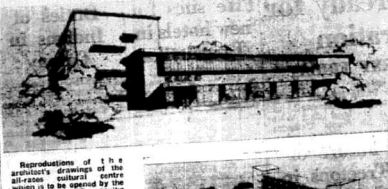

New drug protects cattle

RECENT experiments in Nigeria have shown that there are reasonable grounds to hope that death from trypanosomiasis will no longer exact a heavy toll on trade cattle passing through the tsetse belt on their way to the markets of the south.

During rains The drug used is Antreline. Recent rains continued, and the experiment was started in the middle of the rain when 20 inoculated cattle were left unprotected. Twelve died since the remaining 8 were left exposed to heavy rain from two species of the tsetse fly.

Being repeated On the basis of this experiment it can be said that Antreline will protect cattle for the two months necessary to the tsetse fly and that the use of this antiseptic will not yet have been known to protect cattle from tsetse fly.

Paspalum grass A development encouraged in the Agricultural Department is the planting of a crop of paspalum grass for the purposes of great value to the soil.

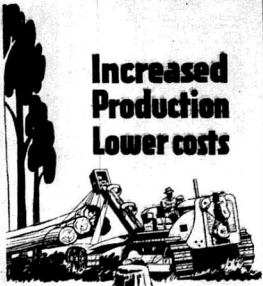
