The arrival of the R.A.F. aircraft was met by a refusal to comment on their presence and an official spokesman said that the aircraft were "being used to prevent the taking of the Argosy to the airfield outside the terminal building to allow an East African Airways flight to leave."

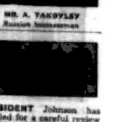

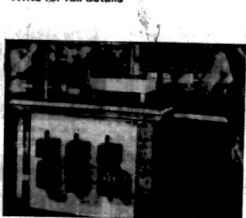

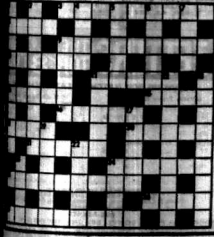

N. A. ACCUSED 'Reluctant to face challenge on oil'

MARGES that the United Nations Security Council was reluctant to face a clear challenge to its authority by South Africa, said oil experts to Rhodesia were made in New York yesterday. They came from the chairman of the U.N. General Assembly's Special Committee on Apartheid, Mr. Achille Mbeki.

It was alleged that it was an essential element of British policy not to provoke the South African Prime Minister, Dr. Verwoerd, and that Britain had tried by every means to maintain the importance of the oil shipments which had been permitted by Dr. Verwoerd.

The Security Council had called for an oil embargo against Rhodesia and was thus faced by a challenge. "It is being ridiculed and its authority is impeding," Mr. Mbeki said.

The oil embargo cannot be permitted to offer this challenge to the Ian Smith regime. We must move to destroy this costly illusion now."

Conservatives warned

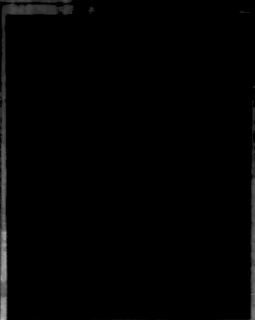

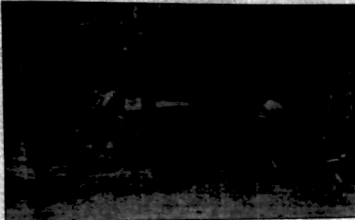

MORE TREMORS ROCK UGANDA VILLAGE

Rescue workers still recovering bodies

THIS little village, nestled among the Mawomoni in north western Uganda, was hit by three major earthquakes yesterday as rescue workers and medical teams continued trying to estimate the death toll of Sunday's earthquake.

Bodies are still being uncovered throughout the widely-scattered Dwariba district where already it has been confirmed that more than 100 people have died. Many residents say this is a conservative estimate — some think it is likely to be more than 200.

But it is unlikely that the exact number will ever be known, for superstitious tribesmen believe that it is a bad omen to count the dead and bury them quietly without informing the authorities.

This once busy thriving little township in a starkly beautiful setting only a few miles from the Congo border is now reduced to rubble. The stone buildings of the traders have been flattened as completely as the mud and wattle huts of the tribesmen.

Desolate women huddle together in the main street with their weeping children while the men struggle among their ruined homes with a forlorn hope of salvaging a pitiful few of their belongings.

Every few hours an earth tremor shakes through the district — a constant reminder of Sunday's disaster which so many of their friends and relatives died in their beds. The grumbling earth has convinced many that a higher tribunal will be coming and they wait in despair without homes, and without anywhere else to go.

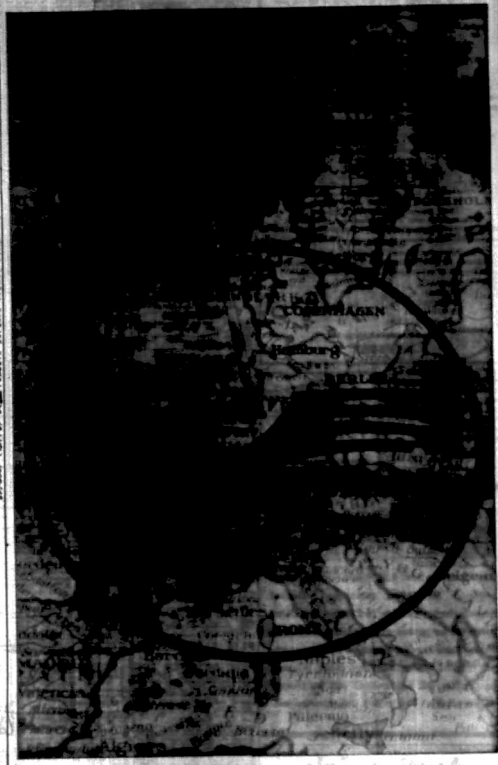
