# THE 1952 OLYMPIC GAMES HAVE STARTED

Rain, lightning at opening ceremony

**S**PEECHES in four languages by the President of the Finnish Republic, Dr. Jalo Paasikivi, formally declared the 1952 Olympic Games open at Helsinki on Saturday.

The Olympic Stadium was filled to capacity of 50,000 spectators for the first time when skaters and officials from all 60 competing countries took up their places in the stands under the national flag and facing the tribune of honour.

Every hand was turned toward the meadow and especially the Finnish runner Paavo Nurmi, Finland's greatest athlete, who had won five Olympic gold medals.

The Olympic oath was never taken, but the American veterans of five Olympic games sang the Hymn of the Games.

Contrary to the tight schedule that burned down for the opening ceremony, the games began.

The skies of Helsinki were very cloudy, but the sun shone brightly to the torch relay.

The British team, dressed in blue shorts and white blazers and white shirts, ran under the blue and white flag.

The Russian delegation, dressed forward as the Russians did in 1917 when it was under the Tsars, was led by the chairman of the delegation, Gen. N. R. Serebryakov.

The continental numbers more than 300 with the United States leading the delegations in the Olympiad.

Four hundred Olympic participants took part in the opening ceremony on Saturday morning, and the games opened on an old fashioned island at the mouth of the river.

One hundred yachts with over 1,000 sailors took part in the opening races yesterday.

The Olympic track and field competition began yesterday at the Olympic stadium with first round heats.

The qualifying tests in the men's high jump and women's discus throwers put on the first day of the games.

In the qualifying high jump, Britain's Eddie Stobart was second and Poland third.



**NEW HOUSING ESTATE  
READY AT NAKURU****Tenant-purchase principle**

WHEN Mr. Norman H. Hailey, Chairman of Nakuru Municipal Board, opened the first of the 36 Asian houses on the Shab Estate, Nakuru, during the last week of June, he established in the history of housing-schemes in Kenya.

Already, great interest has been shown by members and officers of other local clubs for the principle in that of tenant-purchase.

Under the Board's scheme, each householder will be entitled to a deposit of £100, a monthly advance of £10, a monthly deduction of £10, and a sum of £100 over 20 years.

The first 100 applications relate to the houses indicated that open on July 21st a month for each household. "Greatly over crowded conditions" continue to be unavoidable, showed with the opening of the first house.

The houses on the Shab Estate are built in pairs, each pair consisting of two houses, one on either side of a central hall — which, it is suggested, will be used for a common entrance.

Three houses have been allotted to the Indian School, three to the British Council, and three to the Indian School, and other buildings are provided on each site.

**Unit cost:**

Each house will consist of a ground floor of 1,000 square feet, a first floor of 1,000 square feet, lighting, power and water connections, a car park, and all internal partitions and a coat closet.

The site of the first house was sold by the Nakuru Municipal Board for £1,000 when the town council was unable to find money for building facilities for non-government employees.

Mr. Hailey said that the Board introduced by law which enabled him to proceed with the scheme, was a serious threat to the town's more modest citizens if they were to have to pay the same amount.

After discussions with the leaders of the various Asian associations, it was decided to establish, in the town, with the help of the Asian members of the Board, a trust fund to help the less well-to-do Asian citizens to buy their own homes.

A. Hailey said that the scheme, for the Chakwera flats, had been agreed by the Board of the Nakuru Municipal Council in May, 1951, and obtained the support of the Indian Government, whose representative attended the ceremony.

In recognition of the Nakuru 20 years' service to the country, the town's Indian citizens have made a substantial contribution to the scheme, intended to enable them to buy their own homes.
