**£39,500 spent

**Will no longer be sufficient**

It will no longer be sufficient for an intending immigrant merely to come to Kenya and to seek work there.

The Government will adopt the recommendation made by the Immigration Control Board and Appeals Tribunal.

**Immigration**

Immigration will be limited to the kind of Colony needs.

It is intended that the immigrant can earn only to the extent that the Colony can afford to absorb him.

## Road bridge unfinished: Steel 'not satisfactory'

### Chief Secretary blames 'administrative difficulties'

**UNSATISFACTORY** steel bought through the Crown Agents for the new bridge across the Athi River at Nairobi has been delayed in finishing the new bridge, the Chief Secretary, Mr. Turnbull, said yesterday.

The bridge is expected to cost £1,000,000.

Several questions about the purchase were put to the Legislative Council yesterday by Mr. Turnbull, who remitted the matter to the Minister of Home Affairs, Mr. G. H. Turner, and the Chief Secretary, Mr. Turnbull, asked Mr. Markham (Kirkcaldy) to put down a question on the subject.

He said the cost of the bridge was £1,252,000.

This was £200,000 more than was budgeted.

Mr. Turnbull said that although the bridge had been completed, it was not yet ready for traffic.

He said the question was from Col. J. C. Letcher, who had asked for suitable steel to British standards.

## MR. LETCHER NOT TO STAND AT ELECTION

**B**ECAUSE of "administrative difficulties," some Kenya members have experienced in putting payment of their salaries to the Kenyan Government.

This was revealed yesterday in the House of Commons when the Chief Secretary, Mr. Turnbull, said that an investigation had been carried out.

When asked if it was a case of non-payment of salaries to Europeans, Mr. Slade (Aberdare) said that what he meant was very much the same thing, particularly if it existed in this state of affairs.

In reply, Mr. Turnbull said that there was a delay in the payment of salaries to police and civilian staff in the Police Force, which resulted in the frequent strike, with compensation being offered under emergency conditions and administrative difficulties.

### Measures proposed

"The Commissioners and I are agreed on these difficulties," Mr. Turnbull said, adding that measures taken are to be described.

"These include the proposal of the Police Department to account to the House of Commons for all police and personnel, the posting of a police officer to inspect the force, the principal duty of dealing with the public, the establishment of a committee to inquire into the conduct of the police, and the investigation of the powers and methods of the Treasury and Methods Committee."

Mr. Turnbull said no other delays in the payment of salaries were known to have occurred.

Mr. Slade asked if, in future, people who had been asked to leave would be able to get their salaries and get a prompt reply.

The Chief Secretary replied that they would be dealt with much more quickly than under the normal channels."

### Ticks for Council

Two gifts to the Kenya Legislative Council, a table and a pair of tweezers, were presented yesterday at the table of the House for the opening of the session.

The Speaker, Sir Ferdinand de Souza, accepted the gifts on behalf of the House.

## LOAN LAW WAITS FOR NAIROBI

### Agreement soon on housing plan

LEGISLATION planned by the Kenya Government to regulate the formation of building societies for house purchase is not to be introduced until an agreement on the scheme has been gained from an experimental scheme in Nairobi.

This was stated by Mr. G. A. Tyson, Minister of Finance and Economic Planning, when he replied to a question put by Mr. H. W. Wimberley, a member of the Kenya Legislative Council (Member).

The Government's proposals

were published in a White paper last November. City Council may generally support the principles and interest on investment in houses by building societies would make available to the public what the Government may reimburse the Company, had any of it may suffer.

A statement in the White paper said that legislation should be introduced to regulate the formation and control the operations of the building societies and to include all local authorities and the Government.

He said that the Government had said that the interests of shareholders were not to be affected by the consolidation of a District Officer, an agricultural extension officer or a teacher.

All concerned were invited to state their claims before the District Officer, who was nominated by the Government.
