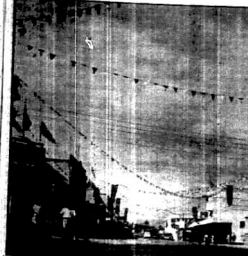

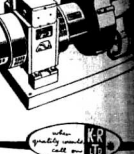
## Mixed penalties

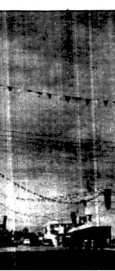

## SECURITY BREAKDOWN AT STALINGRAD

**MORE** than 20,000 Russians wrecked security arrangements for Marshal Tito and Mr. Krushchev at Stalingrad yesterday in the most wildly enthusiastic crowd to be seen by the two leaders since they arrived in the Soviet Union.

The cheering mob swept aside a cordon of troops and police as the Soviet and Yugoslav leaders arrived at the station from Moscow. The situation grew so dangerously out of control that Marshal Tito and Mr. Krushchev fled in their private cars.

The steps were jammed with people who were shouting and cheering. The crowd was so dense that the leaders had to be escorted through it. The situation was so chaotic that security forces were unable to maintain order.

## FOREST FIRE KILLS 19

### BRITISH SOLDIERS Trapped in hunt for Cyprus gangs RESCUE HELICOPTERS FLY OVER FLAMES

NINETEEN British soldiers were burned to death and 18 seriously injured as a forest fire swept down on them as they hunted terrorist Army saboteurs in Kibito and yesterday that was a sudden, rapid change of the wind as the soldiers fighting the fire were caught in the flames.
