"I begin with the end of the war. The three alternatives—a military alliance, a German victory, or an Allied victory. How will the world look revealed from our perspective to-day? It seems to me that the day of the small independent sovereign State has passed. That is the sign of the times. We are unmanageably in for larger groups in that world picture. It is fundamentally models all life and all history."

"I need only point out the fact that the Western civilization are grouping themselves together under the pressure of the times. An outer circle of free democracies is represented by the victors of Hitler, nearly all of which are now in alliance with the British group."

UNDER THE STARS

Mr. Saunders divides the Battle of Britain into four phases. The first, involving twenty-six attacks, lasted from August 8 to August 18. During this phase the Germans were not doing anything but the strength of our general defences, which they found very much stronger than they had expected. The Government was fully confident of subduing Britain with his Luftwaffe. Despite tremendous losses he sent over 1,000 bombers and powerful squadrons. Beginning with six, he threw into the battle first a hundred, then a hundred and thirty, then two hundred, four hundred, six hundred and during the second phase, the attack on Britain's airfields between August 19 and September 5-8 eight hundred aircraft. The third phase, the attack on London, lasted from September 6 until October 5. Mr. Saunders speaks of it as "the crux of the battle" of the attack and his account of it is extremely dramatic. The last phase, from October 6 to October 31, is called "The Luftwaffe in Retreat". Goering by this time was forced to acknowledge defeat. He had lost altogether 1,000 aircraft and this figure as Mr. Saunders points out includes only aircraft which were actually testified to by witnesses as having been seen to fall.

THE BATTLE OF BRITAIN

A little while ago the British Ministry of Information published on behalf of the Air Ministry a small book entitled "The Battle of Britain". This book is not only a history of the fighting - nevertheless a unique document, and the dramatic power with which its story is told puts it in the same class as famous descriptions of battles known to military history. During the day or two of a summary of this great little book has appeared in these columns but we would advise everyone to read it and to get a copy of the original publication which already ranks as a classic. The air fight over Britain in the late summer and autumn of 1940 have been told immortally, yet the world has scarcely any idea of these memorable engagements constituted one of the greatest battles of all times, the most important in modern history and probably, as it now appears, a battle which decided the war.

It is interesting to remember that the Luftwaffe was not so formidable that the Luftwaffe defeated the R.A.F. and thereby paved the way for the invasion of Britain, the whole world might have fallen beneath the yoke of German tyranny. The "Battle Britain" ends with these words: "Future historians may compare it with Marathon, Trafalgar and the day of Waterloo. Those three examples are well chosen. Marathon is the symbol of heroic sacrifice, Trafalgar of martial triumph, and Waterloo the Battle of the Marne furnishes an example of the miraculous fortune that the Allies of Britain and the United States share these three characteristics.

The book which has become a best seller in Britain and the United States has been freely quoted and there is no need to say what has already been printed. Little however has been published about the author, Captain Douglas, who is entrusted the preparation of the book. It is not, as might be imagined, the work of some anonymous committee of experts, but of a writer who, in order to complete his task, had to examine the reports of the pilots' reports, officers' communications and other documents. The reader will feel that the author's concern has been to give the clearest and most intelligible account possible of the great battle which began on August 8 and ended on October 31. This scrupulous account of events based upon a study of the reports of the existing reports, will figure for all time among the masterpieces of military history. Who is the author? His name does not appear on the title-page and who a happy coincidence those who have read the book will find out in the course of our time? 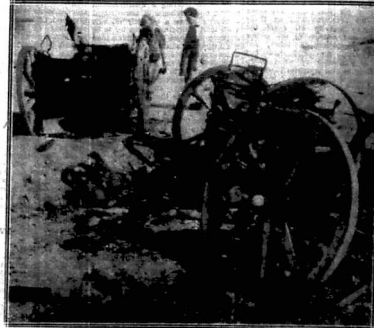

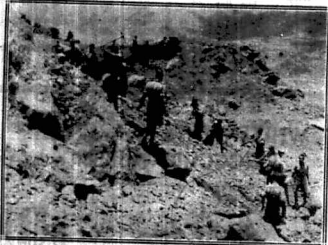

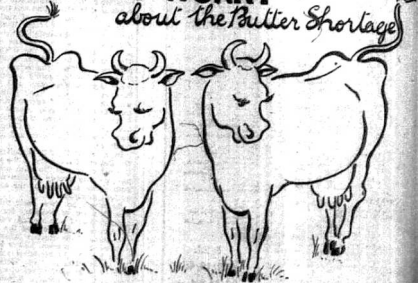
