War In Syria:

THE FEAR OF THE PALM TREE

Way Now Cleared For Further Advance

IN SYRIA the key town of Tripoli has been captured and the way is now cleared for the Allied forces to move on to the coast for several days.

The B.C.C. officer, Richard Dunsley, says in his latest message that information has come into Tripoli which reveals the capture of the town for the defence of Syria. According to Dunsley the capture shows that the Vichy Command must be fighting a rearguard action against our northward advance. It names the British Middle East Forces: Dunsley, Swendsen, Mehke, and Tabor. Only Swendsen remains unaccounted for.

Air Support

Altroops of the Royal Air Force and the Royal Australian Air Force continue to support the land forces in Syria and have attacked many objectives. Vichy aircraft in Beirut harbor was again bombed and destroyed. Swendsen's direct hits were made on the fort and military base.

The Way Cleared

The British Air Force has cleared the way for further progress towards the vital railway junction of Hama. The city fell at 3.30 p.m. yesterday afternoon. The British Air Force is 100 miles from Damascus, and only recently was the pressure put on the Vichy forces to retreat. Government Plans To Purchase Significant Broadcasts

In a card to wool growers, the British Government has not found it possible to make a contract to purchase the Kenya wool clip for the year 1941/2 season, the Government has therefore agreed to purchase both the and the balance of the 1940/1 clip for which shipping arrangements could not be made. Wool for export is expected to average 50 cents per lb. a gross figure that is roughly the equivalent to the price received for the wool. It is found possible to effect sale of the stocks at prices which show a profit on the scheme, growers will receive the benefit, but any loss will be borne by the Government.

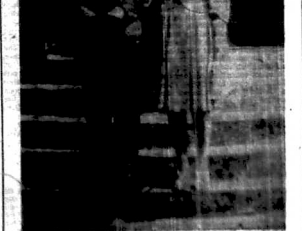

THE EASTERN FRONT

SATURDAY, JULY 5, 1941.

It is too early yet to judge what the outcome of the battles being waged between German and Russian troops over practically the whole of the frontiers of Russia's western borders. So far the only news of the fighting is contained in the official reports issued by both sides and until the rival claims can be checked from more or less independent sources it is impossible to say which more closely represents the true position.

With a long experience of military operations such as was involved in the control of the arms will discount some at least of the German claims and while frankly conceding those which are freely admitted by the Russians who on the whole seem to have more reliable actual facts in the compilation of their own official reports. One thing is quite certain that this is one of the most important phases of the world war and that a very great deal will depend on the outcome of the present fighting.

In recalling the declarations by Mr. Winston Churchill, Mr. Anthony Eden and the British Government regarding the attitude of Britain and the United States to the latest German move, the commentator is reminded of the fact that Germany is opposed by a combination of powers that can ultimately overwhelm her. It goes without saying that it will be possible for the Russian army and air force to maintain themselves in the field and that in addition this combination has been able to attain its full strength and comments that in attempting to assess the position in the British and American press, anxious to avoid unjustified optimism, have perhaps adopted an unduly pessimistic attitude.

Too much (Veritas) says has been made of the admitted lamentable performance of the Russian forces in the earlier stages of the Finnish campaign. When, at the beginning of February, the attack on the Mannerheim Line was resumed, very different tactics were employed and it was not long before they bore fruit. Instead of haphazard assaults by infantry tanks and tanks were delivered which showed that the well planned co-ordination of infantry, tanks, artillery and air force. Political Commissars who had caused much confusion had been withdrawn and combat officers took entire responsibility. Since then the Russian General Staff has had time to study the lessons of the campaign and to invocate methods of modern warfare into their tactics.

In trained and semi-trained manpower Russia draws her

opponent and, in view of the concentration of the industrial production and her dependence on the Red Army, it seems unlikely that it will lack equipment. The position as regards man-power and finance is not so much more doubtful, but the military and air attacks of German Governments have been left unopposed in the west on these matters. The Russian soldier, by training and tradition, is trained to the severest conditions and his will of iron. It is not as though he is as feeble as he is sometimes portrayed as. He is as fit as any soldier in the world. In short the Russian military machine is vast and formidable. Its supply bases are far away from the western front and the broad gauge railways are useless to the German unless they can capture large quantities of British armoured stock. The German armoured divisions, as they advance, will encounter transport conditions more comparable to the Libya road than the mangled roads and village petrol pumps of the Eastern Front. There will be enormous areas of waste to manoeuvre. If the General Staff can weld the various arms into an effective fighting force, and provide the sort of inspiring leadership that all troops of all ages—not excluding the present generation of youth—have seen in the Russian armies, however far they may have to retreat, will remain in being. If that happens the German campaign will have been frustrated."

of all us to consider the implications of triumph. Our work, as a community, is just beginning. The disposal of the forces which remain in this region will depend on the military situation. The British Government has made it clear that so long as the circumstances so require it is intended to maintain military units in Ethiopia, Adal, Ethiopia apart, there are also to be considered the great areas of Italian Somalia and Eritrea. These people must be maintained in working order. Man-power is needed, and money and expertise. These things have been further emphasized by our slender resources. The Civil Services of East Africa and the Sudan have been put to work. We know as O.E.T.A. the Occupied Enemy Territory Administration. Our managements have been made with enemy subjects in some places to carry on the work of production so that the needs of the population may be met. Every day more and more demands are being made on us that the weight of this large area of Eastern Africa, suddenly added to our normal burden, may be carried on our shoulders. On behalf of the rest of the Empire and of the British Government, we in East Africa are mainly bearing that burden and we shall have to find a way. It is a burden in which the public should begin to take an intelligent and a growing interest, and one which will require responsibility presently to tell us what is happening in places like Mogadishu, Kismayu, Kiambu and Masawa, what policy is being followed, what progress is being made towards self-dependence, and what are the continuing terms of man-power and money and how, by the opening up of trade and production opportunities, and what are the concrete results of meeting the expenses of administration. It would hardly be an adequate conception of the value of the services which these conquered territories preserve for a sort of super civil service. These are questions which are probably being up young men who should be in fighting battalions.

what we have already said, the future of the East Africa Force, now at the end of its first and perhaps main task, is a matter which can only be decided by military necessity. 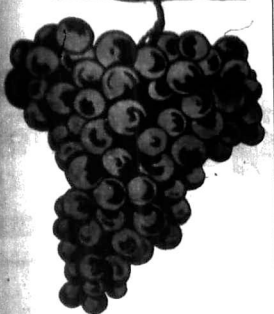

The Supply Board (Coffee Control) yesterday issued the following communication detailing certain of the arrangements for the handling of the 1941/42 coffee crop.

CLASSIFICATION OF PLANTERS' COFFEES:

Minor modifications have been made to the differential scale which was in use during the season 1940/41. The purpose of these modifications is to give a somewhat higher premium to first quality and to provide, as far as possible, no large variation in the quality of coffee of any one class. Grade 37 is to be treated as tenth quality coffee for all purposes other than for export.
