FIRE IN OFFICE OF COUNSEL FOR DEFENCE

But Valuable Documents Saved

ACCUSED'S STORY OF RECEIVING MONEY FROM A FRIEND

The town of Fleming, where the Hauptmann trial is in progress, was the scene of a new sensation on Thursday night.

The offices of the lawyers who are appearing for Hauptmann, which are situated opposite the Court House, caught fire and it was only in the nick of time that certain documents, of supreme value to the defence, were safely removed from the building.

Hauptmann in his evidence denied all the charges brought against him. He said that a friend of his, who had been killed in Germany, had entrusted to him certain of his property on leaving America. Included in this property was a box containing the ransom money.

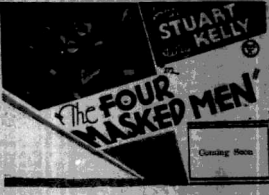

Left for Five Days

The second arrival had given evidence to the effect that the cans had never been moved from the railway premises at Kampala but remained there for five days without any charge, by reason of railway employees' carelessness and their refusal at length removed them from the railway to the Customs warehouse.

Counsel admitted that if that were so, the Director must have been in default of damage charges. If the Crown suggestion was true—that the cans had been moved to the house of the first case—it was likely that the cans would be delivered by him to the Customs warehouse in an obviously dilapidated condition the condition in which they were when the theft of articles was discovered some years ago?

Mr. Fugate asked the Court to pronounce in favour of the accused regarding the cans which the papers showed to have been delivered to the Customs warehouse in an apparently damaged condition. He said that the cans were not the same person or persons who had allowed someone of that name to have access to the cans, which had been recently re-justified.

Nothing Noting Work

The preceding judge asked how many cases had been tampered with.

Counsel replied about 100 out of 150 cases. If he had had taken place during the period between the arrival of the goods at Kampala and their delivery to the Customs warehouse, it was said by an agent of the Customs—although it is not clear whether he was handed over by the accused to the Customs they were in the condition in which they were discovered in 1904, then there would be no ground for any more discretion against the accused. Actually, however, the Customs had taken the case into their hands, and had not noticed anything wrong with the cans at that time. Men, who had been employed there, should not be held liable, unless they were able to produce any evidence to the effect that they were not in the possession of the cans when they were first taken into the Customs warehouse.

When Counsel was speaking of the commission by the Customs in the case of the Aluminium, he said: "I never seem to have any difficulty with the evidence of my own witness as to what he saw, but I am sure that the Customs are not in a position to do so."

Crown Submissions

When Counsel (Mr. Mathew) made his submission to the Court, he said:

1. That the inference that the accused actually removed the metal contents of the cans was not established by the first judge's findings.

2. Applying various inferences on cases of conspiracy to the present case, the first judge had found that the two accused had conspired together to steal the contents of the cans.

3. In fact the presumption that the warehouse was properly carried out in accordance with the Customs regulations was not established.

4. If the Court was satisfied that the theft did in fact occur as alleged by the prosecution the question of whether the warehouse was carried out in accordance with the Customs regulations was really only a matter of evidence, because if the Court was satisfied that the theft did occur before the cases went into the warehouse, the first judge must presume that the officials in the Customs opened the cases, found they practically empty and did nothing about it.

5. The first judge's summing-up put very fairly both the case for the prosecution and the inference.

Counsel proceeded to deal at length with the evidence, suggested that the explanations of the accused were not satisfactory, and the violent presumption that the first judge had made in concluding that the accused were guilty of conspiracy to the present case.

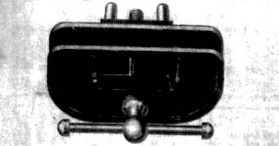
