FARMERS ARE REMINDED THAT THE BOARD MAY BY LAW ONLY PURCHASE PIGS FROM LICENSED PRODUCERS AND, THEREFORE, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT ANYONE WHO HAS NOT YET OBTAINED A LICENCE AND WHO IS KEEPING PIGS SHOULD MAKE APPLICATION TO THE BOARD FOR A LICENCE.

FURTHERMORE, IT IS ADVISABLE THAT ANYONE WHO INTENDS ENTERING THE INDUSTRY SHOULD COMMUNICATE WITH THE BOARD IN ORDER THAT SUITABLE ALLOCATIONS MAY BE RESERVED.

From information which is available to the Board it is apparent that there is a considerable increase in pig production compared primarily by the current abundance of feeding stuffs and the probable fall in maize prices in the near future.

Recognizing this trend, the Board is determined that the trend of 1933-8 should not be repeated and therefore proposes to take measures to ensure that the industry programme in an orderly and planned manner and intends to initiate a system of control commencing on 1st January 1934.

The Board believes that producers will welcome its efforts in this endeavour so that those farmers who are new producers and those who are considering entering the industry can be assured that there will be a profitable outlet for their production.

The Board considers that it is highly unlikely that a position of over supply can possibly make itself felt for at least another nine months, but farmers breeding stock in the boars must know for certain that the production from these animals can be sold profitably when they come to hand in 12 months time. Consequently, it is necessary for the Board to initiate a control system now, although it is not yet clear that these measures are premature.

The system of control envisaged that the industry will pay producers the best possible price for the number of pigs required to supply known markets. Accordingly, producers will be allocated a number of slaughter animals to supply this market, and although the Board undertakes to purchase animals, offered in excess of allocation, this production may command lower prices.

FLOW OF NEWS KEPT UP DAY AND NIGHT

IN its first issue on November 10, 1962, the African Standard gave its readers approximately seven hours of news with headlines which still seem logical, sharp and "freshly cut".

In addition, the East African Standard has continued throughout its life to rely on Reuters, the most authoritative and reliable of the world's great news agencies.

For 60 years it has, every day of the year, the Telegraph Bureau on the second floor of the standard office open to receive news from every corner of the world from Reuters in London. It transmitted its news to every continent as a message in telex or as a message in radio to cable firms and airports on the automatic Ceylon system.

For 60 years the African Standard has been the first newspaper in the East African Standard area to be published in the morning, although being typed by an intensive pair of hands.

Four complete pages are made of news from Reuters messages sent to the Editor and to the Chief Sub-editor for use in the East African Standard area. It is a fact of reference that the other news items in the Standard Department are those which are sent to the Standard Department in the morning by the Telegraph Bureau, the London Agency and the African Press.

For 60 years newspapers are published in Nairobi by the Post Office, in Kampala by the Uganda Post Office, in Dar es Salaam by the East African Standard, in Mombasa by the Standard and in Kisumu by the East African Standard. The staff and service are maintained throughout the group.

AN EXTRA CHORE

IN addition to the regular news items, the African Standard has a special section for the day of the week. This section is known as the "Extra Chores" and is published in the morning. It contains news items which are of interest to the general public and are not included in the regular news items. The "Extra Chores" section is a valuable addition to the newspaper and provides readers with a wealth of information on a wide range of topics.

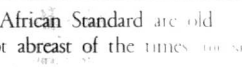

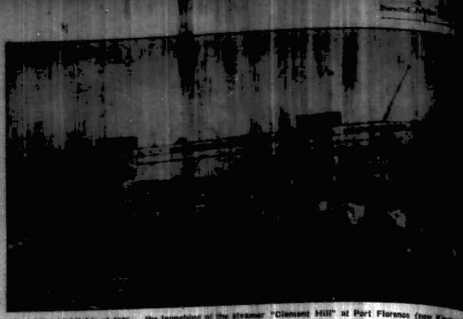
