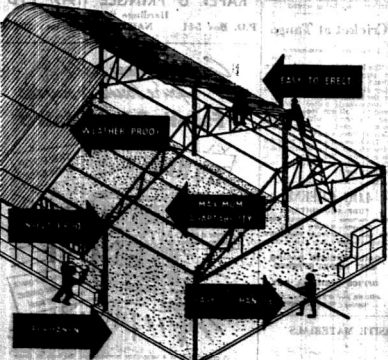

The new African Intermediate Girls' School and the first women's teacher training college in the Rift Valley Province has been opened at the Africa Inland Mission at Kapsabet by Miss Miriam Janisch, Assistant Director of Education (Women and Girls). About 800 girls are attending the school.

The school was opened by the Rev. R. V. Heywood, Superintendent of the Mission, and the Rev. J. M. W. Smith, who presided over the ceremony with a service of evensong to Miss Janisch. The school is situated on a hillside overlooking the Rift Valley. It is a modern building with a large hall, classrooms, and a library. The school is expected to play a significant role in the education of women in the region.





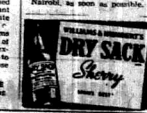

THIS page is torn from the scrapbook of 22-year-old Colin Williams Merrill, son of Lieutenant-Colonel and Mrs. W. E. Merrill of Eldoret.

In civilian life Colin is a commercial artist with an advertising agency but right now he is serving with the Kenya Regiment in their first action. His heroism is not, in fact, his best since the Emergency started.

When opportunity has occurred he has attended events and shown his best when the cause you see here are just a few of a remarkable collection.

The idea came to him when he discovered that National Servicemen, both from training in Rhodesia, had kept a scrapbook of their experiences. And so he decided that he would do likewise for 2 Force in which he was posted at the beginning of this year.

Colin was born in India and came to Kenya early in 1950 to join his parents. His father is manager of Eveready's Wattle Estate at Turbo of the East African Fencing and Extract Committee.

Always interested in sketching and drawing he decided to make it his profession for full time when the Emergency started.

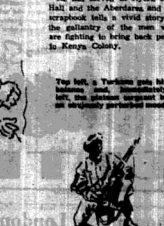

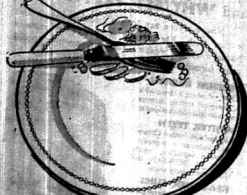

Another £750,000 voted by Council

'NEW ATTITUDE NEEDED'

BEFORE Kenya Legislative Council this week voted the Member for Finance, Mr. E. A. Vasey, reported that there might be a deficit of £225,000 at the end of the year.

He explained that at the end of August, the balance Emergency Fund up to the end of August, the balance was £207,770.
