ELECTED MEMBERS' NEW POLICY FOR KENYA

Call for all races to co-operate

UNITY UNDER BRITISH RULE AND GUIDANCE

THE inaugurated policy statement of the Kenya European Elected Members' Organisation was published last night. Based on the same principles announced by the Leader of the Opposition, Elected Member, Mr. Michael Blundell, at the recent conference of the Organisation, it deals with the Constitution, local government, immigration, social relations, industry and several other topics of immediate and long-term concern.

The main features were underlined and expounded yesterday at public meetings addressed by Elected Members in Nakuru, Nairobi, Nanyuki, Mombasa and Kisumu.

The first call is for the promotion of friendly co-operation between all groups within the framework of British rule and guidance.

Emphasis is laid on the necessity for discussions between the Government and leaders of all racial groups before changes in the Constitution are decided. Parliament, it is stressed, should not be used as a mere rubber stamp on the grounds that it would be an abrogation of leadership and responsibility.

The maximum development of the Highlands—with the full use of the water power of the Tana River—should be the first priority. To ensure the best use of the land in this regard it is suggested that an "Agriculture Bill" be introduced.

Development should be given priority over other matters, and the Government should be given support for the policy of creating a "Kenya" out of the "African" and "European" parts of the country.

Public opinion should be developed through the medium of the press and radio, and a "Kenya" should be created out of the "African" and "European" parts of the country.



ON BOARD THE GOTHIC

A WEEK ago we told the story of the Gothic, the Shaw Savill Line ship in which the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh will make a considerable part of the world tour on which they embark in three days' time. Today York's Handerson, who visited the liner before she sailed for Jamaica, where the Queen and the Duke will room provide masterpieces of interior decoration. It would have been easy, he says, to have had them look like museum pieces. Instead, the decorator has struck just the right note of tasteful informality. The furniture belongs to the Queen, not to the shipping company and the odd rub here, and chair there, proves that it isn't just something new for the occasion.

Like a homely Rembrandt in a frame, top left, Chief John Taylor looks out from the gallery where he will prepare the Royal meals aboard the ship. He has been a sea cook all his professional life.

In the Queen's day cabin, top right, something special in the way of furniture. A coffee stool? A foot rest? No, something much more historic. It is the accolade stool. Colonial and Commonwealth leaders will kneel on it while the Queen dabs them bright.

Centre left, any time during the tour the Queen need only press one of the buttons at the side of this wall map in the Royal stateroom and an electric light will pin-point the ship's position.


In the Queen's day cabin, centre right, the feminine touch is obvious. The period furniture is light and the lowered chairs on the settees and sofas is gay as the Duke's quarters. The telephone on the deck is fitted with a transmitter which makes listening-in impossible.

In his stateroom, below, B.B.C. reporter Godfrey Talbot will record his stories of the tour. They will be broadcast over a specially-installed transmitter, one of the most powerful ever carried by a merchant ship.

Bottom centre, a view which from now on will be accorded only to the privileged. It is the Royal drawing room. The homely, cane-covered chairs and gleaming tables come from Buckingham Palace.

Bottom right, the deck at which the Queen will write her letters to Prince Charles and Princess Anne, telling them about the tour.

Bottom left, the mahogany deck of which Queen Victoria wrote her famous diary aboard the old Royal Victoria, and Albert. On board the Gothic her great-grandson, the Duke of Edinburgh, will use it in his day cabin. The cupboard on the right of the deck will house the Duke's collection of gramophone records.
