THE POSSIBILITIES OF MAKING RAIN IN EAST AFRICA

By D. A. DAVIES

In the second of his assessment of the factors of artificial production of rain, which he presented to the first conference in Nairobi on hydrology and water resources, the East and West African Technical, the Director of the East African Meteorological Department deals with the practical possibilities of development in East Africa.

A detailed study of the results of the experiments so far carried out has established the conditions under which artificial production of rainfall can be described in any article a week ago shows that the practical application of artificial production of rain falls into three classes:
